CHAIR'S CORNER

With the New Year, we all set goals we want to accomplish. These are usually New Year's Resolutions. How many of us set goals (resolutions) so big that we abandon them in February? Is the reason we abandon them because they are so big that there is no way we can accomplish them? I have one question to you. Does the same thing happen in your professional quality roles? How many of us get discouraged because we set ourselves up to accomplish a task that is impossible to complete within the timeframe we set. I want to pose one question that could help you. How do you eat an elephant? The answer is one bite at a time. How does this translate into your professional life? If your goal is to reduce defects on a customer's product by 10%, set a realistic target date. Suppose you set 2 years from today to accomplish this. Next you would want to establish small projects that will work towards accomplishing the 2 year goal. These projects may focus on reducing a particular defect. You may end up with 20 small projects scheduled over the next 2 years that when put together, will accomplish your 10% defect reduction goal. When you approach accomplishing the goal this way, it makes it much more manageable. As you close each project, you become more motivated as you see yourself accomplishing something. Try this same approach to your New Year's Resolutions. You will not be disappointed.

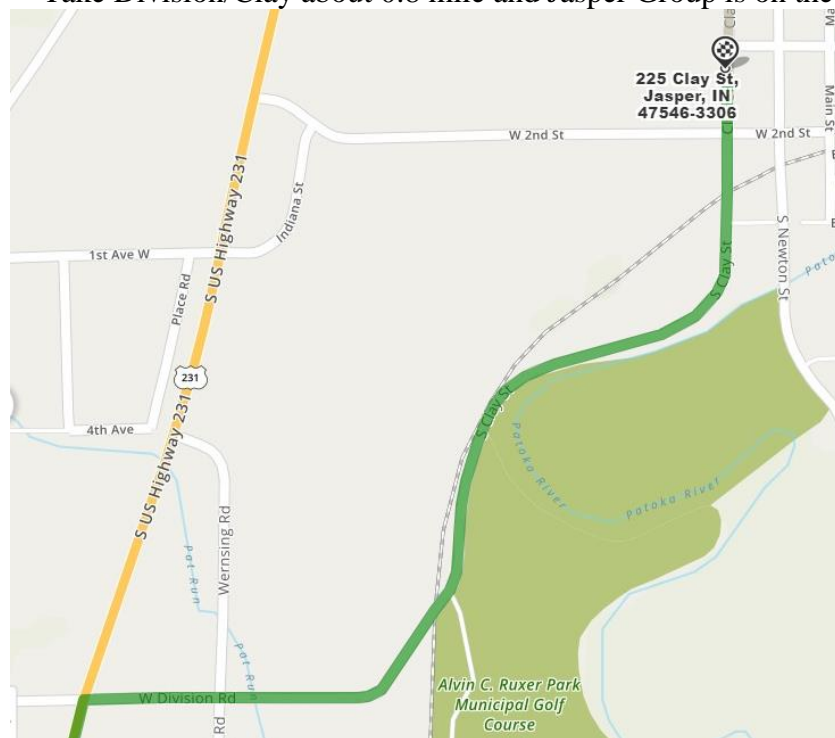


