## The Stickman No. 24 Puzzle Box (Little Game Hunter Box)

The Stickman No. 24 Puzzlebox is a puzzle with a story. Years ago, Robert became intrigued by Kumiki puzzles and attempted to craft a box representing this traditional style. The Stickman elephant puzzle was born from this. The elephant was originally intended as a component to a more elaborate puzzle box, but financial resources ran low and Robert was reduced to cutting off their poor little feet and selling them as simple Kumiki puzzles. A limited edition was never placed on those puzzles as Robert had always intended to come back and finish his intended design.

The Little Game Hunter Box represents the original vision for this puzzle, and finally the Stickman elephant has been properly mounted upon its intended trophy base. The base not only adds two secret compartments that must be discovered, but interlocks with the elephant to substantially increase the



complexity of its solution. The addition of the base produces 15 additional moves to the original design, as well as several false path progressions. In all, this puzzle requires 25 steps to fully solve, and upon completion falls apart into 26 individual pieces that must then be re-assembled.
