IEP Amendment vs. IEP Revision

An amendment is a minor change in a document.

A revision is an alteration or reconsideration in light of further evidence.

So an amendment is used to correct an error or mistake, while a revision is used to add or change information.

Amendment: Changing incorrect dates; deleting info that appears twice; correcting spelling errors; correcting minor errors; etc.

Revision: Adding or changing goals/objectives based on new information; changing placement or classification; etc.
