

THE MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF MARCH 24, 1995

MEETING COMVENED AT 8:30 PM. THERE WERE 34 MEMBERS PRESENT. COMMANDER LEO MILHAM PRESIDING.

PRIOR TO THE MEETING. TONY CIATOLA. GENE RAMERIZ AND RICHIE REICHART THANKED THE MEMBERS FOR GIFTS HE ECIEVED FROM THE POST AND THE CARDS FROM THE MEMBERS WHICH HE RECEIVED WHEN HE WAS OUT ILL.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

MEMBERSHIP-CHARLES FONTANA INTRODUCED NEW MEMBER VINCENT MARRALLI. MEMBERSHIP PAID TODATE WAS 258 WHICH MATCHES OUR MEMBERSHIP TOTAL FOR LAST YEAR. THE COMMANDER SAID HE WAS AWARDED A DUCK AS OUR MEMBERSHIP REACHED 100%. HE THANKED CHARLIE FOR DOING A GREAT JOB.

TREASURER'S REPORT: PAT MESERINDINO REPORTED THAT THE BALANCE OF THE LAST REPORT WAS \$885.10 AND THE CURRENT BALANCE WAS \$1264.10 AN INCREASE OF \$379.
