



FOUND OR ABANDONED KITTENS

Mother cats often leave their litters unattended for many hours at a time. They may be out looking for food or in the process of finding to a new location for her litter.

It is best to leave the kittens where they were found and allow the mother to return to them. If you notice the kittens have been left to the elements, try to shade or shelter them with a portable item such as a cardboard box. Never move, touch, or disturb the kittens.

Many mothers return to their litters overnight during the hours that we are sleeping. However if you are certain that the kittens have been left unattended for more than a 24 hour period you may want to contact your local animal control agency about the next steps for relinquishment.
