## Fire Chiefs Summary - 2020

The year 2020 had presented us all with new challenges due to COVID-19. The members and the Department had to adapt to the public health measures that were changing frequently. Together as a team, we continued to thrive and provide fire protection to our community and those surrounding us.

As a result of COVID-19 protocols and PHM's, the Department responded to less Medical Assistance calls than previous years. The Department and the members responded to a total of 107 calls in 2020; 64 of the calls were daytime calls between the hours of 6:00am and 6:00pm. Out of these 107 calls for assistance from the public, 71 (66%) calls were to assist our neighbouring Mutual Aid Departments in their time of need. Outside of the regular Wednesday Night Training and Meetings, in 2020, the members volunteered a total of 943 hours in the support of local community events. This again shows the continued bond and requirement we have with our Mutual Aid departments.

Over the past year, the members continued to display their true devotion and dedication to the department and the local communities in the time of need. In total, the members volunteered a combined total of 3207 hours in assistance, support and training within the Department. Out of these hours, the members had a combined total of 1073 hours alone on calls. Although 66% of the department calls were daytime, the members continued to maintain an average of 6 members responding during our busiest hours. As our busiest times are daytime calls it proves the importance and value of maintaining a strong and dedicated Mutual Aid Group within East Hants.

Overall in 2020, the members of Milford and District Volunteer Fire Department have displayed that they are truly dedicated to the community, the department and our Mutual Aid partners. The Department will always be ready and willing to respond in the time of need.

As the incoming Fire Chief, I am humbled to have this opportunity to work with the membership in continuing to provide exceptional fire service to the community and surrounding areas. It is an honour to have the privilege to represent you within the East Hants Fire Service.
