A cursory analysis of the statistical data from this report should be demonstrative of the quality of performance of this agency in realizing the contractual obligations and the overall achievement of the goals and objectives of this Agency and the Toll Road Division.

A total of 320 man-hours was scheduled; 192 man-hours were actual dedicated to patrol functions. 128 hours were exhausted on vacation time, workers compensatory, and/or COVID sick leave. 192 hours were 990 total miles were driven and the shift responded to 422 total service calls. The shift issued 1 traffic warnings,





Stolen vehicle and Warrant arrest*








