

We strongly suggest notifying Village Hall of the dates of your absence and we will be happy to complete a vacant premise form on your behalf. This form is recorded with the NCPD 4th Precinct and our own Village Security force and will assist in patrolling the neighborhood. This information is kept strictly confidential and helps secure the community by highlighting unusual situations such as an open garage door or parked service vehicle at a vacationing homeowner's premises.

We need your help in proactively securing our community by **locking your car doors**, using your alarm and keeping your property well illuminated. There are many **crimes of opportunity** during this time of year and being proactive drastically mitigates this risk.
