As Lent prepares us for the glory of Easter to come, there are some spiritual movies that will be coming out in March and April. The first one to be released will be **"I Still Believe."** This movie comes out on Friday March 13. It is based on the true story of Christian musician Jeremy Camp and his wife whose faith were tested with her illness. As an added bonus actor Gary Sinise plays Jeremy's father in this movie. We all know how the Gary Sinise Foundation built a house for Nick and Lauren Vogt! This movie was made by the same people who made the movie "I Can Only Imagine", which was an outstanding movie. During Holy Week, there will be special event showings of the stage play "**Jesus**" from Sights and Sounds at the Cinemark theatre in Ontario. The play was filmed in front of a live audience and will be shown on the movie screen Tuesday April 7 at 6:30 p.m., Thursday April 9 at 6:30 p.m. and Saturday April 11 at 12:55 p.m. Because these are special event showings, the ticket prices are more expensive- \$12.50- But isn't Jesus worth it! The running time is listed as 2 hours and 20 minutes. Seeing this play would be a great way to celebrate Holy Week and prepare for the glory that is Easter!

After Easter Day, but still very much in the Easter season will be a new movie about Our Lady of Fatima. The movie is simply called "**Fatima**." It is set to be released on Friday April 24. You can go to YouTube and type in 'Fatima movie trailer' to get a preview of what looks like to be a great movie. 
