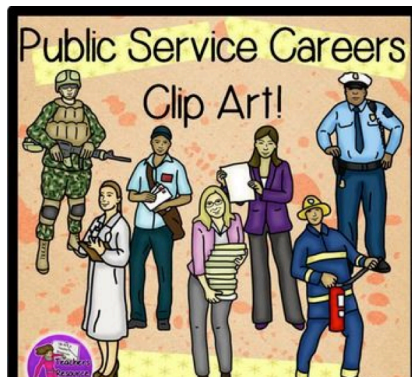

To name a few: doctors, nurses, police, fire, ambulance drivers, grocery workers, sanitation workers, teachers, postal workers, military.

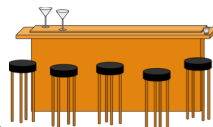

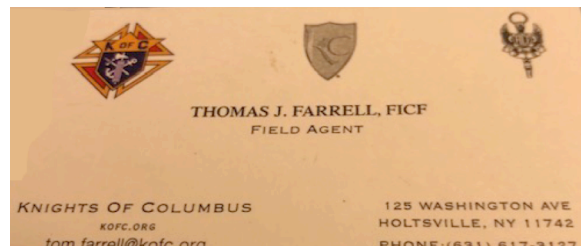
