Jesus. The teens were munching on peanuts while I was speaking, and one teen tossed a peanut at me. Everyone got quiet. I was thinking, "Okay, what would Jesus do?" A few ideas came to mind that involved lightning strikes and turning over tables...but then, I envisioned Jesus sitting next to me...with maybe a mischievous

look in his eye, and a grin on his face. Then he picks up a peanut, tosses it back...and laughs about it. So, that's what I did. I tossed a peanut across to the other end of the table. Just as the teen picked up his glass to drink, the peanut bounced off his forehead and dropped in his glass. Everyone laughed and we had a good time.

Later that night, I thought more about

how I was a teacher to teenagers, but they were also a teacher to me. It's one thing as we mature, to put away childish behavior. But that doesn't mean we put away child-like fun. Sometimes, as we mature into adults, we forget to have fun. I realized I don't want to be a person who takes everything too seriously. I encourage you, don't take *yourself* too seriously. Take *fun* seriously. Schedule some fun into your calendar.



Food for Thought: A Job or A Ministry

Some people have a JOB in the church; others involve themselves in a MINISTRY. What is the difference?

- *If you are doing it just because no one else will, it's a JOB.
- *If you are doing it to serve the Lord, it's a MINISTRY.
- *If you quit because somebody criticized you, it was a JOB.
- *If you keep on serving, it's a MINISTRY.
- *If you do it only as it does not interfere with your other activities, it's a JOB.
- *If you are committed to staying with it even when it means letting go of other things, it's a MINISTRY.
- *If you quit because no one praised you or thanked you, it is a JOB.
- *If you stay with it even though nobody recognizes your effort, it is a MINISTRY.
- *It's hard to get excited about a JOB.
- *It's almost impossible not to be excited about a MINISTRY.

An average church is filled with people doing JOBS. A great and growing church is filled with people involved in MINISTRY. Where do you fit in? What about you?

If GOD calls you to a MINISTRY, don't treat it like a JOB. If you have a JOB, give it up and find a MINISTRY. God does not want us feeling stuck with a JOB, but excited and faithful to Him in a MINISTRY.

An encouraging poem by James N. Spurgeon tells it all:

A job is at your choice;

A ministry is at Christ's call.

In a job you expect to receive;

In a ministry you expect to give. In a job you give something to get something;

In a ministry you return something that has already been given to you.

A job depends on your abilities;

A ministry depends on your availability to God.

A job done well brings you praise; A ministry done well brings honor to Christ.

Sunset Sailing Cruise (Sat.) Sept. 2nd at 6 pm


