The "Coats for Kids" fundraiser was a success again this year. Thanks to everyone who donated, we will be able to put 216 winter coats on children in need. Our "Ultrasound Initiative" was also a success. Council #1266 was able to provide \$5200 towards a new ultrasound machine to be placed in a clinic. We should be very proud of this accomplishment! At the November 1st meeting, we found out that the machine will be placed in a clinic located on the campus of MSU. The original clinic and the back-up clinic that were selected as candidates could not meet the all the different requirements for placement of an ultra-sound machine. As the fund-raising program was already well underway the State Council sought another location. The clinic on the campus of Michigan State University was chosen, and approved. NOTE - 51% of abortions are performed on women that are less than 25 years of age. 1/3 of the 51% are college students. Even though the Ultra-Sound Machine will not be in the Southern portion of the Diocese, the important thing is that there will be a new ultrasound machine put in place to help end abortion.
