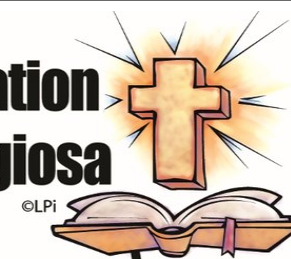

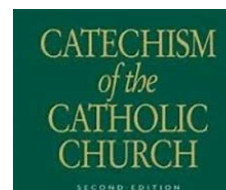

### **THE NATURAL LAW**
