**OUR MISSION** is for every diver to reach their maximum potential through a combination of effective coaching, inspired effort, and supportive family culture.

NDC strives to provide instruction for young athletes to learn to dive to the best of their ability through the use of strength and conditioning activities and training on diving boards and platforms. Our program is designed to teach the art of diving while incorporating time management, goal setting, self-discipline and team building skills in the safest possible environment.

#### DIVING AFFILIATIONS

There are two national diving affiliations which sanction diving meets, USA Diving and the Amateur Athletic Union (AAU). Membership with USA Diving is required for a diver to practice with NDC and compete in most meets. There may be meets which require your diver to also be a member of AAU.

NDC uses an on-line service (diversets.com) which electronically manages live competitions and provides a detailed history of your diver's past competitions, as well as being able to look up other divers' past competitions, throughout the country. Most registrations for the meets we will attend will be registered through diversets.com. Details on joining and using this software program will be provided by the coaching staff and/or Parent Representatives.

#### **DIVING LEVELS**

Our program consists of four levels:

Learn-To-Dive Jr. Elite High School Prep (HSP) Junior Olympic Squad (JOS) **Learn to Dive:** The Learn-To-Dive program is structured to develop physical skills and to teach basic diving technique.

**Junior Elite:** This program is for divers who have demonstrated satisfactory achievement of physical skills and the proper training attitude at the Learn to Dive level. Junior Elite divers are encouraged to participate in competitions in Novice level competitions and may be eligible, based on skill level, to compete at the Junior Olympic (JO) level. Advancement to the Junior Elite level will occur at the invitation from the coaching staff. Year-round commitment to training is mandatory.

**High School Prep:** This program is for divers, of any age, who are preparing for high school diving and choose to train, during various times of the year, such as during the high school diving season or during the summer months, but chose not to participate in the year-round program.

**Junior Olympic Squad:** This program is for divers who have demonstrated a commitment to competing at regional, national, and international meets and have demonstrated success at national level competition. Advancement to the Junior Olympic Squad level will occur at the invitation from the coaching staff. Year-around commitment to training is mandatory.

Training schedules, monthly fees, and Annual Membership Fees are specific to each level.

The coaching staff will communicate with parents regarding the level at which your athlete will train, based upon your child's skill levels, training attitude, and commitment to the sport. If a diver continually fails to complete practices (does not attempt dives they are able/asked to do, does not follow coaches instructions, or does not demonstrate respect for coaches, etc.) that diver may be asked to return to a prior level, in order to work on and reestablish basic skills, before being allowed to return to the higher level on the team. If this situation arises, coaches will communicate their concerns with the diver's parents.

We believe that being a member of the Nebraska Diving Club program is a privilege and an honor. We provide the following information to assist you and your child in reaching their highest possible potential with our club. Club membership, placement, and grouping are at the sole discretion of the coaching staff. The coaching staff has the full discretion to accept or reject the application of any athlete for membership.

#### TRAINING SESSIONS

Training is the most important facet of the Nebraska Diving Club program. Competition is the ultimate assessment of a diver's progress and an emphasis is rightfully placed on success at competitions, however, it is at practice is where the diver's values, potential, and foundation for success is established.

Our program is available on a year-round basis, and all club members are expected to train on days and

times, as agreed to between the coaches and parents. Divers are able to participate in additional training sessions throughout the year, at the discretion of the coaching staff. Periodic changes to the agreed-upon schedule may be pre-arranged with the coaching staff.

Please try to attend every training session from beginning to end. Tardiness, early dismissal, and absences can be disruptive to the other athletes. If your child is unable to attend practice due to illness or other legitimate reasons, please contact the coach, if possible, prior to the scheduled practice. This will allow us to make changes as needed to your child's training routine.

The Nebraska Diving Club web site (nebraskadivingclub.com) has a calendar showing scheduled practice times and other information, such as upcoming meets or changes in practice schedules.

There are times when the Head Coach may be away at diving competitions. Those divers who are not participating in the competition will continue to train with another NDC coach. If there is not another coach available, no practice will be scheduled. There may be occasions when there are changes in predetermined training schedules. On those occasions, we will communicate those changes as far in advance as possible. We are not able to provide for make-ups for missed or canceled practice sessions.

Support your coaching staff, teammates, and the NDC program. Working together for the benefit of all is an important part of team spirit. Keep these things in mind for every practice:

- Athletes must give coaches their full attention, follow directions, be safe, and be prepared to dive when it is their turn.
- Athletes must be respectful to the coaching staff and teammates.
- The coach has a responsibility to discipline/re-direct a diver while at practice, but primary discipline remains with the parents. Ongoing behavioral concerns will be communicated with a diver's parent.
- There has NEVER been a diver that has not "smacked" or "crashed" while diving. It is an unfortunate part of our beautiful sport. Refusing to try dives or skills is unacceptable. Our coaching staff will not ask a diver to attempt a dive or skill that is beyond their ability.
- Please make sure your athlete brings the following to each training session:

A positive, team-oriented attitude

Shorts and t-shirt

Shoes and socks

Swim suit – worn to practice

Towel

Water Bottle (inexpensive one please – they get left behind/lost easily)

- Younger divers must come to practice with their suits on and having used the restroom.

  Coaching staff cannot help young divers change clothes or escort them to the restroom during practice time.
- Younger divers must have a parent/guardian available for pick up at the end of practice. Coaching staff cannot supervise divers before or after practice times.

#### **COMMUNICATION**

Parents who wish to watch their children during training sessions must sit in the main grandstand on the south side of the pool. Our intention is to provide the best possible training and learning environment. Experience has proven that divers and coaches focus better at practice if the deck area remains clear of spectators.

Parents are asked to refrain from talking to the coaches or divers during the training sessions, due to safety concerns and as to not interrupt practice. Parent/coach conferences are welcomed and can be arranged in advance, by appointment.

The primary contact for the coaching staff is Kris Hoffman. E-mail/text correspondence with Kris is preferred over phone calls. E-mail correspondence should be used to discuss concerns, ask questions, or to arrange for a coaches meeting. Please make sure your e-mail address is on the Registration/Release form. #### **VOLUNTEERING**

The Nebraska Diving Club staff and parents work together to make Intrasquads, meets, get-togethers, and fundraising activities successful throughout the year. Parents and divers are asked to participate in planned activities in order to promote team unity and give NDC members an opportunity to get to know one another.

We will also plan Intrasquad Meets and/or Skills Challenges for the Learn to Dive, High School Prep, and Junior Elite Team as possible, depending on scheduling and availability of the Devaney pool.

#### NEBRASKA DIVING CLUB

Nebraska Diving Club athletes are required to abide by the Practice Policies and Behavior Expectations, Rules and Regulations, and Travel Team Code of Conduct. The following documents must be signed by a parent and athlete as a condition of program participation.

#### PRACTICE POLICIES & BEHAVIORAL EXPECTATIONS/RULES AND REGULATIONS

All scheduled practices/meets must be attended unless arrangements are made in advance with the coaching staff. A member of the Nebraska Diving Club team may not participate in any training session or competition without the prior approval of the Head Coach.

Profanity and/or derogatory remarks during training and/or at competitions are not permitted. Use of unacceptable language will result in immediate dismissal from that day's training or competition. Repeated use will result in suspension or dismissal from the team.

Use of alcoholic beverages or any drugs, in the training or competition environments (other than those prescribed by physician or approved by a parent/coach) is not permitted, and will result in suspension or dismissal from the team.

The coaching staff selects team suits and warm-up apparel with family economics in mind. All divers participating in diving competitions are required to wear team apparel to local and away meets, as well as at opening ceremonies and during award presentations.

Club membership can be terminated at the discretion of the coaches for:

- Failure of divers or parents to support Nebraska Diving Club in a positive manner
- Failure to pay coaching fees and/or other required fees
- Failure to follow any portion of this Membership Agreement
- Actions considered by the staff to be detrimental to the club
- Continual lack of attendance at training sessions
- Continual failure by an athlete to complete practice sessions as instructed by the coach

#### TRAVEL TEAM CODE OF CONDUCT

The purpose of this Travel Team Code of Conduct is to promote the best individual and team performance, assure your child's safety and well-being, and to promote a favorable image of the Nebraska Diving Club as ambassadors of our sport.

The coaching staff will provide advance meet schedule information. Using that information, parents must arrange for their diver to be at the meet site at the scheduled time for practices and competition. Parents and/or divers are responsible for completing their diver's entry forms and paying meet fees. Coaching staff will answer questions with regard to completing entry forms or signing up for meets.

We understand it is not always possible for parents to accompany their athlete while traveling. Each diver must be accompanied by a responsible adult, at all times, and club members are encouraged to make arrangements with other club parents to act as guardian for their child. At competitions requiring overnight lodging, club athletes are required to stay with a parent or an adult accepting responsibility for the diver. The arrangement and cost of transportation, meals, and lodging are the sole responsibility of the parent or guardian of the diver.

The coaching staff is responsible for club divers only while they are coaching on the pool deck. Additional rules may be provided by the coaching staff for certain meets.

#### **OFF-SITE TRAINING**

There may be occasions when the coaching staff invites individual divers to attend an off-site training with supervision only by coaching staff. These opportunities are designed to enhance the performance and skills of divers of various levels or age groups. Divers and their parents will accept all responsibilities associated with these opportunities and understand that the diver's behavior reflects the standards of conduct of the Nebraska Diving Club. Curfews will be established for each trip by the coaching staff and divers must be in their assigned room at the designated curfew time. No one except the assigned roommates will be allowed in the room after curfew time. Indiscreet, destructive, disrespectful or other behavior considered to be detrimental to the Club will not be tolerated.

Violations of the Code of Conduct may result in one or all of the following:

- The diver may be withdrawn from the competition or off-site training.
- The diver may be sent home at his/her expense.
- The diver may lose all club privileges, including travel to future away meets.
- The diver may be placed on probation, suspended from the club, or dismissed for a period of time depending on the severity of the club rule infraction.

PARENTS/GUARDIANS: We request you take the time to review the Code of Conduct with your athlete and to fully explain the responsibilities associated with the privilege of overnight travel. Traveling and competing with your teammates can be a wonderful experience. These rules are in place to insure that trips are safe, successful and enjoyable for everyone.

WE HAVE READ AND UNDERSTAND THE ABOVE CLUB POLICIES AND BEHAVIOR REQUIREMENTS, RULES AND REGULATIONS, AS WELL AS THE CODE OF CONDUCT AND AGREE TO ABIDE BY THESE POLICIES.

#### MEMBERSHIP AGREEMENT

This agreement shall be in effect from the date signed through August 31<sup>st</sup> the following year. Those applying for and signing this Membership Agreement agree to be bound by the rules and regulations, fee schedules, and late charges in effect or as amended, for the term of this agreement.

Monthly coaching fees are due on the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month. Please have your diver bring payments to one of the coaches on the deck, on or before the 1<sup>st</sup>. It is very difficult to keep track of payments that come in several weeks late or are "doubled up" from the previous month. Payments not received by the 5<sup>th</sup> of the month will be subject to a late fee of \$10.00 which will be added on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of the month.

Any athlete whose monthly training fee is 10 or more days delinquent will not be permitted to train or compete.

JSO Divers: Monthly coaching fees are based on an annual figure. Fees are not pro-rated and no credit will be issued if a diver misses a practice session or if the coaching staff schedules a break in the training schedule. Your position as a JSO member, in the same training group/time, will be reserved as long as you are current with your fees. In the event that coaching fees are not received, your spot will be made available to other divers. This policy will be enforced except in the event of a prolonged illness or injury, which will be addressed on an individual basis.

#### ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP FEE

An Annual Membership Fee is due from each club member on September 1<sup>st</sup> of each year. This fee will be paid upon joining, or re-joining, the club any time during the year. Those divers who join the club mid-year will pay their Membership Fee in full (fee will not be pro-rated), and will pay the subsequent Annual Membership Fee each September 1<sup>st</sup>, upon re-signing the contract. The Membership Fee covers NDC membership and NDC administrative costs for the year.

#### TRAVEL EXPENSES AND COACHING FEES

Prior to traveling to an away meet, the coaching staff will provide the coaches cost of travel, meals, and lodging to the athlete's parents. The cost will then be equally divided among the divers who are *participating or qualified for the meet*. You will be notified of the due date for this payment. Failure to provide full payment by the due date may result in the diver being removed from the competition and any fees that have been paid will not be refunded. Coaching fees are in addition to expenses for the coaches travel, lodging, and meals. When NDC hosts a meet there will be no additional coaching fees. Coaching fees for away meets are as follows:

One day meet: \$30.00 per diver Two day meet: \$60.00 per diver Three or more day meet: \$80.00 per diver

#### NDC COACHING FEES

The coaching staff will communicate individually with parents regarding the diver's level. Jr. Elite and JSO divers are required to commit to year-round training and competition.

# Monthly coaching fees are due on the $1^{st}$ day of each month. The Annual Membership Fee is due by September $1^{st}$ of each year.

Weight Training: **JOS** divers are required to participate in a minimum of two weight training sessions per week @ \$10.00 per session. Divers who are not on the JOS may also be able to participate in weight training and need to speak to the coaching staff.

Additional Belt Spotting -15 minute sessions are available on Saturdays and can be arranged with Kris @ \$25.00 per session.

Private lessons are available as pre-arranged with the coaching staff at the rate of \$50.00 for one hour. The fee for semi-private lessons (2 divers) is \$30.00 per diver for one hour.
