When delegates go "informed" they will hear the opinions of the C&BL committee and the discussion on the floor before deciding how the branch will vote. Each delegate is permitted to vote independently if a consensus cannot be reached. Note: Our branch voting strength is 4 Votes.

Below is brief summary of each General, C&BL and SR Resolution:

# **General Resolution:**

Resolved Summary: "FRA National Headquarters hold a minimum of a 1-year moratorium on withdrawing any funds, distributing Life Mem-bership PCT Funds to all Branches, and National FRA bank accounts until the Life Membership Program is in compliance with the FRA National C&BL Sections 913 and 914. A report of the status of the compliance shall be made by the FRA National President 60 days prior to the 2023 National Convention."

# Constitution and Bylaws & Standing Rules Resolutions:

### Article 3, Section 309(b) (Eligibility for Membership)

Resolved Summary: Transfers may be accomplished by a signed letter requesting a transfer an electronic message requesting a transfer, or a phone call to FRA Member Services by the member. Requests for transfer shall be accepted from branch secretaries as well as individual members desiring to transfer.

# Article 6, Section 606(b) (National Convention)

Resolved Summary: That Article 6, Section 606 (b) be deleted; and the remaining sections of Section 606 be renumbered, and Section 607(a), C&BL, FRA shall be amended as: "Section 607(a). Each Branch shall have five (5) votes regardless of Members in Good Standing as of 31 March. Branches instituted on or after 1 April shall be allowed one vote until the following 31 March."

<u>Article 8, Section 810(b) (Duties of Officers and Committees)</u> Resolved Summary: "The chairmen of standing committees shall make an annual report of their activities to the National Board of Directors and to the National Convention, with such recommendations as they deem proper. Recommendations requiring action by the National Convention shall be submitted in accordance with Section 612; The chairman may schedule meetings via teleconference, video conference or in person to discuss recommendations.

<u>Article 8, Section 813(a) (Duties of Officers and Committees)</u> Resolved Summary: "Section 813(a). The committee shall consist of the National Vice President serving as Chairman and each of the Regional Vice Presidents as members, with the Director of Membership Development serving as an advisor.'


# Article 8, Section 819(a) (Duties of Officers and Committees)

Resolved Summary: "Section 819(a). The committee shall consist of a chairman and eight members, one from each region.

Article 15, Section 1508 (d), (f) (Miscellaneous) **Resolved Summary:** FRA Cap Regulations - "The purchase of an FRA uniform cap is optional (in accordance with Section 1511) by members of the Fleet Reserve Association and its wear shall be as follows:", and Section 1508 (d) replace the word "authorized" with the word "issued", and Section 1508(f). - Guidelines/Etiquette." be added reading "The FRA Uniform cap should only be worn by members only when in attendance at official FRA meeting or accompanies on as official synchronic and the size of th meetings or ceremonies or as official guests at patriotic or other civil functions of by individuals when officially representing The Fleet Reserve Asso-ciation on public occasions. The wearing of any political paraphernalia, obscene or distasteful, or demeaning items is strictly forbidden.'

# SR 5(a)(1) (Committee Reports)

**Resolved Summary:** "Reports shall be submitted on forms provided by the National FRA website which is maintained by National Headquarters. Committee Report Forms may be changed only by action of the delegates



registered at a National Convention".

<u>SR-5(a)(2) (Committee Reports)</u> **Resolved Summary:** "Each Branch shall submit the following reports if the Branch President has appointed such committee: Americanism-Patriotism, Hospitals, Welfare and Rehabilitation, Public Relations, Youth Activities and Veterans Service to the regional chairman of the appropriate committee prior to the convening of the regional convention. A copy of these reports shall be submitted to the Regional President, Vice President, FRA National Headquarters and one copy retained in the branch files".

# SR-5(b)(1) (National Awards)

Resolved Summary: National Awards be amended to read: For the purpose of competing awards addressed in this standing rule, branches shall be assigned to competitive groups as follows: a. Group I - 413 members or more. (9) b. Group II - 213 to 412 members. (15)

- c. Group III 113 to 212 members. (15)
- d. Group IV 63 to I 12 members. (45) e. Group V 10 to 62 members. (72)"

<u>SR-5(b)(3) (Committee Reports)</u> **Resolved Summary:** "Each Regional President shall submit the action of the regional convention to the chairman of the appropriate national committee. Only first place winners for each competitive group will be forwarded to the appropriate national committee. Included with the recommendations shall be a copy of the branch committee reports of each membership group and the name of the shipmate nominated for national recognition, if applicable. A copy of the report shall be forwarded to the National Executive Director.

<u>SR-5(b)(5) (Committee Reports)</u> Resolved Summary: "Each national committee shall review the regional chairmen's reports and recommend a branch from each membership group to receive national recognition, and if desire, a shipmate to be named Fleet Reserve Association 'Shipmate of the Year' for that committee. The award for the branch of each membership group shall be a streamer three inches wide and thirty-six inches long and made from ribbon material. The streamer shall contain the FRA Emblem and shall be lettered with the committee name, membership group number, placing within that group, and the year awarded. Streamers shall be blue in color for first place, red in color for second place, and white in color for third place. FRA National Headquarters shall provide these streamers to the committee chairman prior to the convening of the national convention. The shipmate approved by the delegates to receive the Fleet Reserve Association 'Shipmate of the Year Award' shall be awarded a plaque and a Certificate of Appreciation signed by the National President.

## SR-5(c) (National Awards)

**Resolved Summary:** "Membership and Retention -The National Mem-bership and Retention Committee shall make a thorough review of the reported membership progress of the various branches for the preceding 1 April - 31 March. The Committee shall take all available factors including gains, losses, location, and annual regional officers' reports into consideration to recommend the winners of the National Membership and Retention Awards. The annual Membership and Retention awards will be: The Charles E. Lofgren Membership Award for Branches, The Abraham M. Rosenberg Membership Award and The Frank J. McPherson Memorial Award."

### SR-5(g) (Veteran Services)

**Resolved Summary:** Amended by adding: "SR-5(g). The National Committee on Veteran Service shall select two outstanding Shipmates, one as outstanding Veterans Service Officer (VSO); and one for outstanding VA Voluntary Service (VAVS); with one selected overall outstanding member recognized as "PRPNC Rosemary Posekany Memorial Award" for National Veterans Service

### SR-7(e) (Disaster Relief Fund)

**Resolved Summary:** Be changed to read as follows: Standing Rule 7, SR -7(e). Initial withdrawal from the fund shall be limited to \$2,500.00 per family. One additional withdrawal, up to the same amount, may be authorized in the same manner as the first.
