At the September 12 th meeting the proposed new by-laws changes were voted on. All passed with the exception of Article IV: Officers and Board Members

Section 1: Officers

K. To be eligible for the Commodore position candidates must have served on a MLBC board for at least one year.

At the October 3 rd Membership Meeting we will be voting on one additional change to the by-laws which was read and discussed at the September 12 th Membership Meeting.

Article XV: Use of Revenue

A: All funds and assets of the club shall be used only for the purposes that are consistent with the purpose of the club and for actual administrative expenses in conducting the affairs of the club under the direction and with the approval of the Board of Directors. All expenditures of more than \$2,000.00 for club improvements must be discussed at a regular membership meeting. Must be accompanied with a minimum of 2 bids, and upon acceptance, published in the bulletin and voted on at the next regular or special meeting where a majority of all members present is required for acceptance.

Proposed change/add: "in the case that two bids are not received in a timely fashion one bid may be accepted.

MLBC 2021 Buck Pool – Sign up at the clubhouse bar no later than close of business Monday November 14, 2022 for the Whitetail Rifle Season opener on November 15 th . MEMBERS ONLY. The entry fee is \$10 per member. Harvest your Michigan whitetail buck between Nov.15 through Nov. 30. Only Michigan deer may be entered. Deer must be hunted FAIR CHASE on public or private land. NO HIGH FENCE OR PRESERVE HUNTS! Submit your INDISPUTABLE proof of kill with clear pictures, documented date of kill, number of legal points (one inch or more) to the Boat Club no later than December 4, 2022. A Banquet Night will be announced soon.
