She was president of the Huron County Chapter of the Michigan Association of Retired School Personnel (MARSP) and served on the State Board of Directors. She was a charter member and current secretary of the Ubly Lioness Club. She was also a charter member and current secretary/treasurer of the Ubly Historical Society and a former member of the Huron County Historical Society Board of Directors. Because of her interest in local history, she researched and wrote a history of the Village of Ubly in 1968. Marilyn was coeditor of the Family History Book, published in 2000. In 2001 she compiled the pictures and wrote the captions about Ubly for the Huron County Historical book. She helped compile local history to be published in Celebrating 150 Years of Huron County, Michigan, 1859-2009. Marilyn served as treasurer of the Sleeper Public Library Board of Directors. She was a member of the Ubly Thursday Nite Ladies Bowling League for many years. She enjoyed spending time with her family, books, crossword puzzles, bowling and traveling.

Marilyn is survived by her daughters, Danna Mose of Fort Gratiot, Donna Schrimer and her husband, James of Imlay City; her son, Daniel Schneider and his wife, Laura of Sterling Heights; three grandchildren, Garet and Griffin Schrimer and Caitlin Schneider; one sister, Esther LaMothe and her husband Roger of Jackson; two nephews.

She was preceded in death by one brother, David Gray in September of 1959.
