Solo Master Class Competition

Competition Description:

The Solo Master Class Competition is open to all flutists currently enrolled in a college or university. There will be two categories for this competition: undergraduate and graduate. Each applicant may record any solo work or movement of a solo work of their choice. Applicants will be judged based on accuracy of rhythm, intonation, and technique and overall interpretation and musicianship. There will be one winner chosen from the graduate applicants, and three winners chosen from the undergraduate applicants. The winners will perform the work of their choice for the 2018 guest artist, Jim Walker, in the Solo Master Class, on April 7, 2018. The master class is open to all registered festival attendees

Competition Requirements (recordings must be emailed and registration forms & payment must be postmarked by 5:00 pm on February 15th, 2018):

Record **one** work OR one movement of a work of your choice.

- The recording must be **unedited**. *Edited recordings will be disqualified.*
- Do not speak or make any identifying sound on your recording.
- Previous winners are eligible to participate.

To Submit Your Recording:

- 1) Email your recording in MP3 format to louisianaflutecompetition@gmail.com no later than 5:00 pm on February 15, 2018.
 - In the subject line of your email, enter LFS 2018 SOLO MASTER CLASS COMPETITION.
 - In your email, include your name as you prefer it to be listed in the program.
 - List the school and program (Undergraduate/Graduate) in which you are currently enrolled.
 - List repertoire selection.

*To be eligible for the Solo Master Class Competition, you are required to be a member of the Louisiana Flute Society. Registration for the festival will pay annual membership dues.

Materials submitted after February 15 and/or without payment will not be considered.
