Habitat for Humanity Returning to Two Harbors with Age in Place Repairs Program

Two Harbors, MN - Western Lake Superior Habitat for Humanity (WLSHFH) will again partner with the Two Harbors community September 9 - 13, 2019 to repair homes as part of the Age in Place repairs program. This program partners with aging homeowners to support their efforts to safely maintain their homes as their needs evolve. By partnering with Habitat, homeowners retain independence and a renewed connection with their community.

The repairs will make senior's day-to-day tasks easier, and include: re-building outside stairs, installing access ramps and railings, cleaning and installing gutter systems, replacing window trim, and landscaping, among other projects.

WLSHFH is looking for program applicants to be considered for this year. To be eligible for the repairs, homeowners simply need to: own their home, be willing to partner with Habitat, and meet our income requirements. To begin the application process, homeowners can call the Habitat office or visit our website.

WLSHFH is also seeking volunteers in the Two Harbors community. Volunteers should expect to work hard and make a big impact in their neighbors' lives. WLSHFH provides all the tools and materials needed, and arranges lunch for each volunteer. Those interested in volunteering should contact the Habitat office.

Age in Place in Two Harbors is possible this year because of major financial support from the Lloyd K. Johnson Foundation, the Duluth Superior Area Community Foundation, and Essentia Health. Community Partners of Two Harbors is a major community supporter. All organizations have identified the Age in Place program as a great way to partner with older adult homeowners in order to build community around the region.
