We would like to add Provision E to the Constitution, Article II, objects as follows, for membership approval at the July election: E. FURTHER: IWLA YORK CHAPTER NO. 67 IS ORGANIZED EXCLUSIVELY FOR CHARITABLE, EDUCATIONAL, AND SCIENTIFIC PURPOSES UNDER SECTION 501(C)(3) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE, OR CORRESPONDING SECTION OF ANY FUTURE FEDERAL TAX CODE.

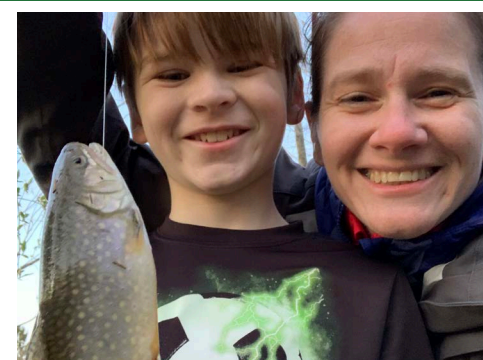
