DO NOT WAIT. By getting started this summer the requirement will be very easy to fulfill. Community service hours are **required** for graduation from Foothill Oaks Academy. Eighth graders will only be allowed to participate in Grad Week activities, if service hours were on time and accounts are paid up.

- 6th graders - 5 hours
- 7th and 8th graders - 10 hours

For each service performed these requirements must be fulfilled:

1. Fill in the Community Service Log Sheet attached with this letter and be sure to get the signature of the person in charge of the project, or a parent if you organize the event yourself
2. All hours must be completed and documents turned in to Mrs. Hastings no later than **Friday, May 10, 2019**
