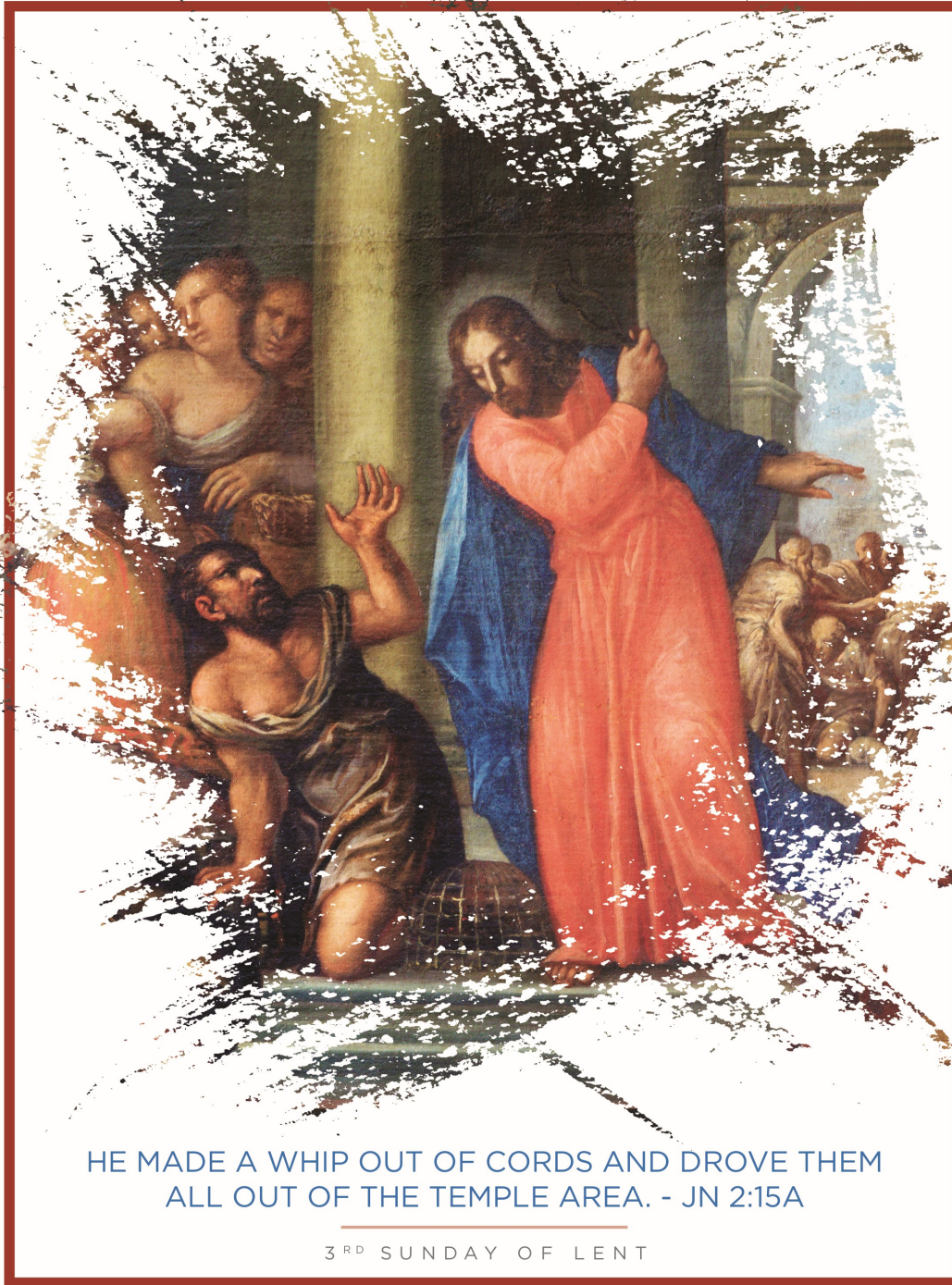

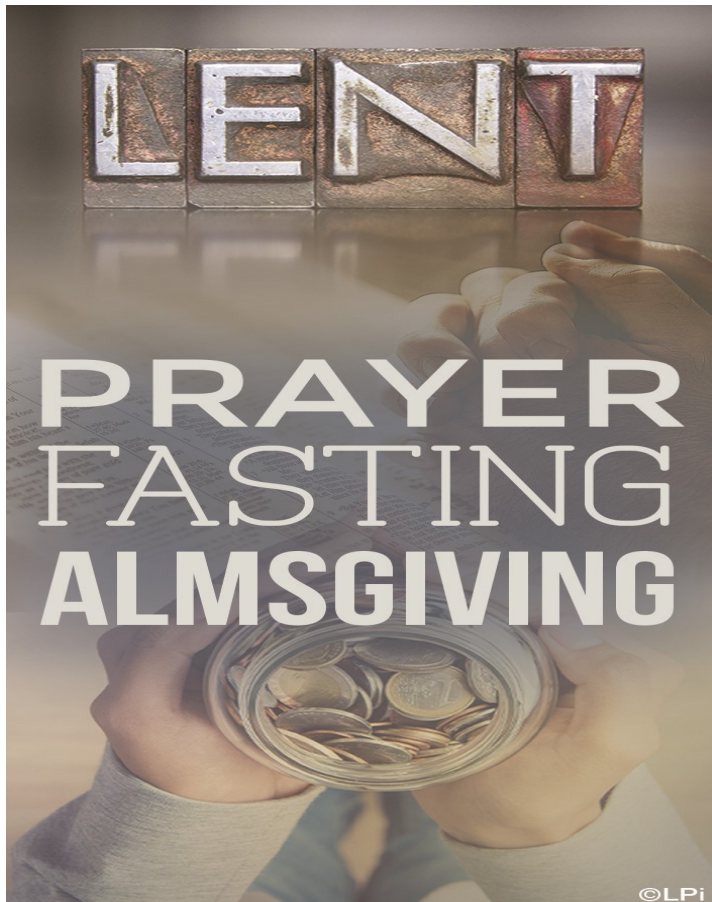

## 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of Lent

Sunday March 7<sup>th</sup> is the 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of Lent! Has your family been making Lent special this year? What are some things you have been doing for prayer, almsgiving, or fasting? Even if you haven't done anything yet this Lent, challenge yourself to start now!

This week as a family go through your clothes or toys.

Whatever is still in good condition donate to St. Vincent de Paul to help families in need.

## Saint Joseph

We're in the year of Saint Joseph. We celebrate Saint Joseph's feast day on March 19<sup>th</sup>, but many celebrate this great saint for the entire month of March. Can you name some of the symbols we associate him with? What about who he is the patron saint of? Some examples of symbols are: a carpenter's square, a lily, a ladder, etc. He is considered the patron saint of the Universal Church, of workers, of fathers, of the poor, of craftsmen, and of a happy death among others. As a family each night this month ask St. Joseph to intercede for us, or say a Novena to him.

## Families in Faith

This week our 1<sup>st</sup> Communion Class learned about *listening*. They listened to the story of the farmer who sowed seeds. Some landed in the road where the birds ate them. Some landed in the rocks where they could not grow. Some landed in thorns and weeds that choked the growing plants. But some landed on healthy ground, and they grew strong and tall. This week as a family read this story together and pray the Lectio Divina with it. You can find the parable in Matthew 13:3-8

The children also learned about the Liturgy of the Word. This is the first part of the Mass where we sit and *listen* to Scripture. Encourage your child to sit and listen to the Liturgy of the Word at Mass. Ask them questions about the bible readings and the homily.

## Text Updates

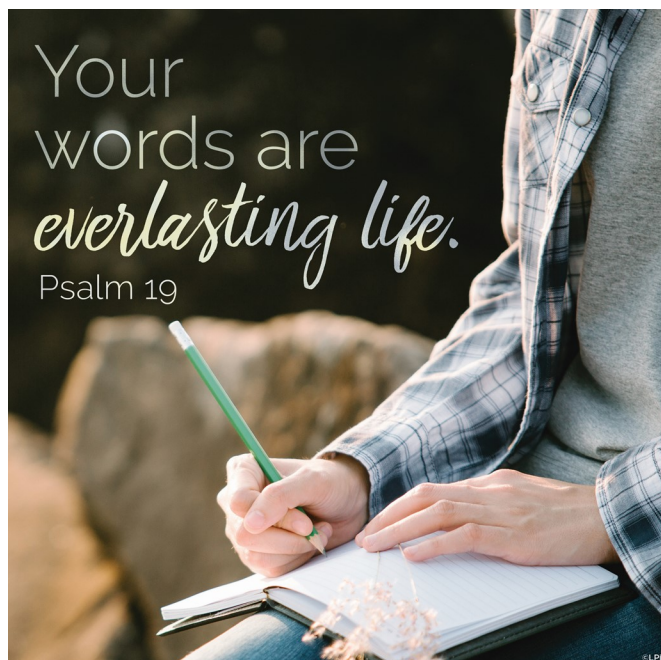
