## Makes many changes to the chapter:

- The scope is amended to apply to exotic animals determined to be invasive
- Removes definitions of carnivores, herbivore, hybrid of a wild mammal, not native to or generally found in Delaware, omnivores, primates, reptile, and subject creatures
- Adds definition of exotic and invasive species
- Removes the requirements for an exotic animal permit (enclosures, treatment, public nuisance prevention, inspections) and removes the types of permits and removes the failure to obtain a permit section
- States the Department and State Veterinarian have authority to determine if an exotic animal species is invasive through rules, and if so, makes them banned for sale, trade, breeding, import, barter, gifting, release, and auction no permit issued for them
- Notice will be issued if a species is invasive, and before the notice, owner must tag and register the animal, cease breeding, provide adequate housing and secure fencing, report escapes in 12 hours, house males and females capable of breeding separately, obtain Invasive Animal Permit, and allow inspections
- Declares feral swine and potbelly pigs invasive
- Requires Exotic Animal Permit for any species not invasive and not exempt
- Grandfathered owners of invasive species with Exotic Animal Permit must obtain Invasive Animal Permit
- Removes authority to refuse to grant a permit if cancelled, Department must notify permit holder
- For escapes, replaces subject creature with invasive animal species and requires reporting in 12 hours
- Adds violations section if permitted invasive animal species is at large without ID and Department cannot notify owner, it can be immediately euthanized; if invasive animal species kept with Invasive Species Permit, the Department must notify owner of violation; If owner does not comply, Department may seize and euthanize the animal without notice; If individual or business is selling invasive animal species, animals may be seized and euthanized

- Related to: Adds reference to statutes regarding definitions, endangered species, commercial guides, permit issuance, license required, physicians to report persons bitten by animals, and quarantine of animals suspected of rabies
- Related to: Removes reference to 150.290 and 150.305 regarding wildlife breeder sale and transport and possession out of season
- Authority: Adds local government authority to regulate inherently dangerous animals AND destruction or control of animals causing damage
- Necessity: Adds 50 C.F.R. 21.29 is for holding raptors for falconry purposes
- "Enhanced Rabies Surveillance" replaces area with zone
- "Native wildlife" replaces man with humans, removes exclusion of naturalized introduced species, adds those that have naturally expanded their range into KY without humans
- Rabies vector species now includes hybrids of listed species
- Permits to hold wildlife in captivity exempts annual transportation permit, falconry permit and captive-bred native wildlife (except fox or coyote) imported or held in temporary facility 10 days; Also limits exemption section to AZA
- Northern bobwhite shooting areas must comply with 301 KAR 2:041 regarding shooting areas
- Snapping turtle limited to common snapping and references the law regarding turtle take
- Bullfrogs can only be taken during season and references rule
- Spring lizards removes from 25 limit and references live bait for personal use rule for dusky salamanders
- Falconry permit ADDS exemption from noncommercial permit and transportation permit for those raptors

- Raptor definition replaces family with Order includes all birds not subject to MBTA
- Falconry definition replaces with "caring for and training raptors for the pursuit of wild game and the hunting wild game with raptors" includes wild take for falconry and caring for, training and transporting for falconry
- Adds definitions for possession, native wildlife, permanent exhibitors, temporary exhibitors, hacking, hybrid and imprint

- For exams, requires purchasing exam fee each time test is taken and to re-take the exam and score 80% if there is a lapse in permit
- Requires random drawing at end of Aug for peregrine falcon must be General or Master class or non-resident and fill out Peregrine Falcon Take Permit Application by Aug 15 (16th if Sunday) Trapping from Sep 20 to Oct 20 and must be 1st year and passage banded birds must be released and reported to TWRA Falconry Coordinator
- Adds that a permittee with raptor propagation permit, raptor education permit or raptor abatement permit may sell, purchase or barter a captive-bred raptor with seamless band for falconry BANS wild raptors and may only transfer them
