

This Wednesday, February 17th, is Ash Wednesday. Traditionally on Ash Wednesday the priest marks our head with the ashes in the sign of a cross. However this year the Ashes will instead be sprinkled over your head. This is actually the norm in many places of the world and isn't something 'special' the Church decided to



do because of the Pandemic. This comes from the Biblical tradition of putting on sackcloth and ashes as a sign of Penance (Neh 9:1).


