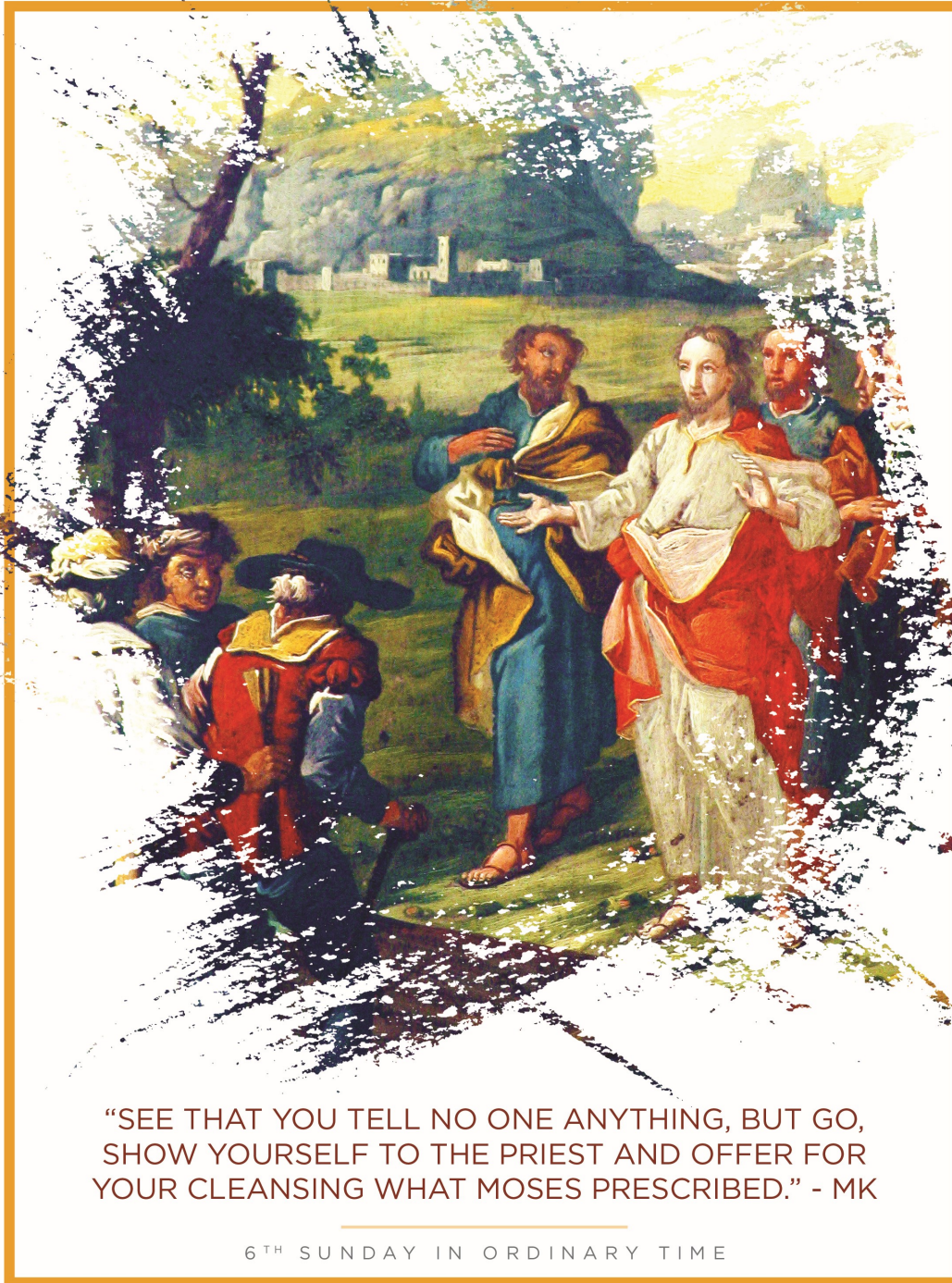

1. He is the patron of the Universal Church.
2. In the Litany of St. Joseph, he is referred to as "the terror of demons," the "glory of home life," & "model of artisans" amongst other descriptors.
3. Devotion for St. Joseph goes back to at least the 9th century, when he was commonly referred to as "*nutritor Domini*" meaning "guardian of the Lord."

## Ash Wednesday:

This Wednesday, February 17<sup>th</sup>, is Ash Wednesday. Traditionally on Ash Wednesday the priest marks our head with the ashes in the sign of a cross. However this year the Ashes will instead be sprinkled over your head. This is actually the norm in many places of the world and isn't something 'special' the Church decided to



do because of the Pandemic. This comes from the Biblical tradition of putting on sackcloth and ashes as a sign of Penance (Neh 9:1).

This week you'll see the colors in the Church change from **green**, representing ordinary time, to **purple**, which represents penitence and royalty.
