Landscaping/Grounds: Three trees are dying in the common area. We are going to take a look at them and make a decision at the next meeting.

Architecture: No report.

Docks/lifts/seawalls: No report

Streets/Roads: Scott has a quote to fix potholes for \$875. Scott was unable to attend and there were some questions and the bid. Justin said he would check with Scott.
