Adam is currently the minister of Discipleship, Connection and ANCHOR (Recovery) at North Atlanta Church of Christ. Susan Paa is a licensed clinical social worker, serving in key roles supporting adults and children in crisis. She has been the Director of Forensic Services for the Fulton County District Attorney's Office, Director of Admission at MARR Recovery, child service caseworker, and currently serves as a hospital social worker at Children's Healthcare of Atlanta. Susan is highly regarded in the fields of addiction and childhood trauma. The Paas both received their BSW from Abilene Christian University and their MSW degree from the University of Texas at Arlington.
