

September 17, 2017 Twenty-Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time Gospel Mt 18:21-35

"I forgave you your entire debt because you begged me to. Should you not have had pity on your fellow servant, as I had pity on you?"

O my God I am heartily sorry for having offended you, and I detest all my sins because of your just punishment, but most of all because they offend You my God who are all good and deserving of all my love. I firmly resolve with the help of your grace, to sin no more and to avoid the near occasion of sin. Remember saying that? Remember when? Senior members of the Catholic Church recognize it as the Act of Contrition said at the end of our confession we made every week, whether we needed it or not. It has fallen into disuse, but it has the elements essential to the reception of the Sacrament of Reconciliation - awareness of how we have damaged our relationship with God and others; sincere sorrow for our sin; a firm determination not to change. Jesus challenges us to be responsible for the state of our relationship with God and others by treating others as we want God to treat us. If we are not willing to forgive others, should we expect God to forgive us? Is it time for a good Act of Contrition?
