

Summary of Events

Robbery:

11700 Glenway Dr. - Deputies were dispatched to a robbery, where it was reported unknown suspect(s) followed him home from the bank and took his money by force. Case is under investigation.

Other Calls:

12300 Moorcreek Dr. - Deputies responded to a suspicious person call, where it was reported 4 known suspect juveniles were trespassing on the complainants property and checking car door handles. Deputies arrived and detained the juveniles. The juveniles were given trespass warnings and returned to their parents.

15500 Wealdstone Dr. - Check Fraud - Deputies responded to a check fraud call, where it was reported unknown suspects are stealing checks after being mailed through the US Post office and forging the complainant's checks.

12415 Louetta Rd. – Major Accident – Deputies responded to a traffic accident, where a known female having a medical emergency drove into the Lakewood Forest Fund. Office. The driver was transported in stable condition to a local hospital.

Deputies responded to 6 residential alarms that were all cleared as false or cancelled.

Deputies responded to 4 suspicious vehicle calls that were all cleared as gone on arrival or information.

Deputies performed numerous traffic stops within the contract increasing visibility and reducing potential crime in the contract.


