FOOD FOR THOUGHT


We will continue to serve quality meals that meet and exceed expectations. Even though cost and product availability have been skyrocketing, we have been able to carefully manage cost, this gives us the option of continuing the more expensive items you have been enjoying. As of now we serve over 120 different Entrée's and 45-60 different sides, soups and desserts. We will continue to offer a variety of dishes to keep the menu fresh but understand that if items are not chosen then eventually, we remove them from the rotation until they are asked for again. A couple of things I want to remind everyone about. If you do not circle a time for your meal, then it will ALWAYS be delivered. If you bring your menu selection in LATE you may not always get what you ordered, late is after 1pm Tuesday. Please always put your name and unit number on your menu, all days as we cut those up per day. If you cancel your meal, please get the name of the person you cancelled with for accountability on both ends. All your concerns are conveyed to all kitchen staff, if you have a problem, it is important to get the persons name so I can address it with that person.
