

AYR PROTOCOL FOR 6/27/20 MATCH

This protocol is based on the **SASS "Best Practices for conducting Matches in a COVID-19 Environment" document dated 5/30/2020.**

We are following these "best practices" for the Arizona Yavapai Rangers 6/27/2020 match.

If you are sick , or even if you think you may be sick, **please do not attend the match.**

Please bring your own PPE , such as masks, gloves, hand sanitizer. Sanitizers will be available at the registration table, scoring tables & the porta-potty.

Bring your own water! Plenty, cause it's going to be hot. Bulk water will be provided to refill your own containers, but no cups will be provided.

The loading table(s) will be 10' long. **No more than 3 shooters** can be at the LT at any time, 2 loading & 1 shooter loaded & ready to go to the firing line.

We will NOT be using sticks/flags to delineate spotters.

Two shades will be provided on each bay, one for shooters, one for score keepers. Bring your own umbrellas, cause we need to spread out the gun carts.

Timers will be in disposable plastic bags and should be changed with each TO handoff.

TOs should consider, but are not required to, wearing mouth/nose covering while on the line, especially if you have a tendency to cough/sneeze because of allergies.

Please limit scorekeepers on each posse to a minimum, 2-3 per posse. iPad screens should be sanitized at scorekeeper handoff.

Each shooter will be responsible for maintaining their personal score cards, which will be provided at registration. Otherwise, shooters will be able to see their stage times when the scores are posted online.
