Slow Stitching Thursdays Feb 15, 22, and 29 10:00-noon \$12 per class
To slow stitch is to take time to mindfully create something new through hand stitching. In the three classes you will learn the basic embroidery stitches and embellishments to get started on your own slow stitching project.


Modern Trees Friday Feb 2
No paper piecing for these liberated trees and every one is unique! Bring $11^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{\prime \prime}$ fabrics.

Log Cabin Trim Tool- Creative Grids Saturday Feb 3
Let Creative Grids Log Cabin rulers help you create these traditional blocks. The rulers come in $4^{\prime \prime}, 6^{\prime \prime}$ and $8^{\prime \prime}$ in both original and curvy blocks. The newest $10^{\prime \prime}$ Log Cabin Duo lets you make blocks with $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ or $1^{\prime \prime}$ finished size logs.


Hexagon Y Seams Friday Feb 16


This quilt can build your confidence sewing $Y$ seams, which really aren't as difficult as you might think! Use the Hexagon Trim Tool by Creative Grids to accurately cut your fabric shapes.

## Plaidish

Saturday Feb 17 One of my new favorite quilt patterns! You can play it safe and use just three colors or test your skills in sorting fabrics to darks, mediums and lights! Either way, it makes for a fun quilt! You'll download the free pattern from Kitchen Table Quilts, then I'll give you the measurements to make a smaller size too!



Fidget and Memory Quilts Friday March 1
Create a fidget quilt for a child or adult. An introduction to the many techniques to create textures and "things to do" blocks for a child's busy quilt. Purchase a Fidget Starter Kit or be prepared with your own kit.
Materials- *Assorted $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares of fabrics including
 cotton and minkee ${ }^{*} 9^{\prime \prime}$ square minkee and $9 "$ square
Texture Magic (or Fabric Magic) *Assorted ribbons (these items are included in the Starter Kit available separately)
OR Create a Memory quilt for an adult. A most sophisticated look incorporating a variety of textures and folded fabric techniques. You can include men's ties, bits of clothing, laces and buttons. Kits of textured fabrics will be available $\$ 20$. Kit includes zipper, minkee squares, texture magic, faux leather and other textured materials.
Materials- *Assorted fabrics to create blocks- can include men's ties (washed), clothing *Buttons- individual or sets of 3-5 matching *Laces or trims *Ribbons

Cat's Cradle Creative Grids Saturday March 2
An amazing ruler that lets you cut only rectangles to create a block of triangles! Bring fabrics with good contrast. I have made several quilts using variations of this versatile block! The ruler comes in two different sizes, to make blocks from $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ to $8^{\prime \prime}$ finished!


Color Wash Saturday March 9
A simple block with a stunning result! Use batiks and prints in a variety of colors. You'll want to have the Creative Grids $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square ruler.

Wonky Log Cabin Creative Grids Friday March 15
Create a wonky, happy block with the help of the Creative Grids ruler!


Diamond Strings Saturday March 16
A new scrappy quilt using your strips and strings!
 Begin with 5 " squares and create this fun new quilt!

Gordian Knot with Sara Crow Friday March 22 10:00-4:00 \$30
Partial seams make this intricate knot possible! You'll finish the quilt top during the class. Sara will bring several sample.

I'll share several variations of this simple quilt block to inspire! It's become one of my go to scrappy patterns.

## Hexagon Trim Tool Creative Grids

Saturday April 6
This versatile ruler helps you create complex looking hexagon blocks. We'll look at several options for centers, color placement, and settings.


Confetti Friday April 12
A creative way to use bits of batik fabric. Come see my Confetti quilts/ pillows for inspiration, then create your own art! Bring a base fabric (approximately $12 \times 12^{\prime \prime}$ or larger) and bits of batik scraps. You'll need rotary cutter and small Ziploc bags. You can bring a photo for inspiration or copy one of mine

Concentric Squares Saturday April 13
Begin with $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ center squares. These can be fussy cut if you desire. The variations are endless- brights, 30's, theme fabrics, color sets! A fun way to focus on fun fabrics and use up your smaller stash fabrics!


Crazy Santas Thursdays May 16, 30, June 13 and 27 \$10 per Class 10-noon For this class you need a basic knowledge of hand embroidery stitches. While you won't create a Santa that looks exactly like mine, I'll share seam treatments and wool applique patterns you can use to create your original Santa! This class assumes you will be working at home on seam treatments between classes.
Class 1- May 16- Piecing Santa/ Beginning Seams Bring *Christmas, red and green fabrics. *Sewing machine. *Muslin (2) $8^{\prime \prime} \times 13^{\prime \prime} * P e r l e ~ c o t t o n ~ i n ~ s h a d e s ~ o f ~ r e d / g r e e n / w h i t e . ~$
Class 2- May 30- Applique pieces
Class 3- June 13- Seam Treatments
Class 4- June 27- Finishing Santa Bring *Sewing machine. *Polyfil stuffing *Needle and thread to match Santa fabric *wool for beard *beaded trim, fur, cording as desired.
