

## **PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTIONS AVAILABLE IN THE STATE OF MAINE**

**Homestead Exemption** - This program provides a measure of property tax relief for certain individuals who have owned homestead property in Maine for at least twelve months and make the property they occupy on April 1<sup>st</sup> their permanent residence. Property owners receive an exemption of \$10,000 from their assessed property value.

**Veteran Exemption** - A veteran is eligible for an exemption of \$6,000 who

- a) served during a recognized war period and is 62 years or older or
- b) is receiving 100% disability as a veteran or
- c) became 100% disabled while serving.

**Paraplegic Veteran** - A veteran who received a federal grant for a specially adapted housing unit may receive a \$50,000 exemption.

**Blind Exemption** - An individual who is determined to be legally blind receives an exemption of \$4,000.

Applications for all exemptions are available at the Montville Town Office.

Due Date: Applications must be turned in by April 1<sup>st</sup>.
