Take a look at a violation on the opening jump <u>here</u>.

This specific situation where the blue jumper catches the ball illegally (it did not touch the floor or another player) is addressed in case play 6.4.1 Situation C part d. In this case, white gets the first possession at midcourt and blue gets the arrow.

Short and sweet, but starting the game correctly is important!

Tuesday Extra: When we have a player with 5 fouls, as described yesterday, make sure that your partner(s) know this also...we don't want a throw-in or free throws happening while the DQ'd player procedure is happening.

Tuesday Bonus: On another table note, make sure to make eye contact with the *official scorer* when reporting fouls, not the timer!
