Paul C. Shoup, 71, of Caseville, died Wednesday, Nov. 18, 2009 at Huron Medical Center after a short illness.

Paul was born May 24, 1938 in Fairfield, Conn., to the late Paul L. and Laura (Pendleton) Shoup. He graduated from University of Detroit High School and University. He retired from Comerica Bank as the chief purchasing agent. He moved to Caseville upon retirement, though he had been visiting the area for many years beforehand.
