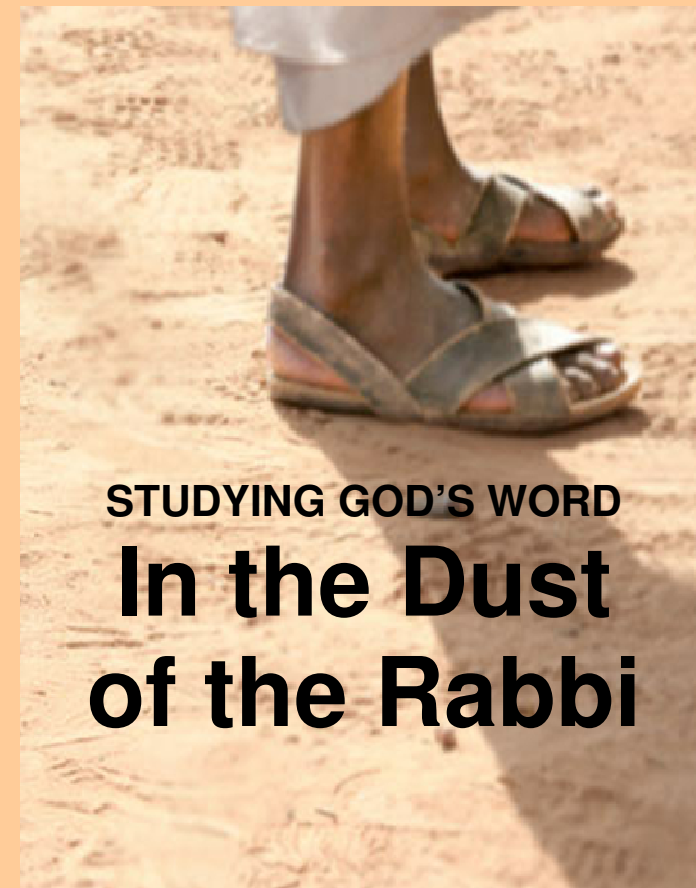

ISRAEL ITINERARY

NOV 1 **Depart USA**

NOV 2 **Arrive Tel Aviv**
Arrive Tel Aviv. We make our way on our own to our Tel Aviv hotel.

OVERNIGHT TEL AVIV

NOV 3 **Tel Aviv / Caesarea**
Mt. Carmel / Meggido / Nazareth / Galilee

This morning, our guide and driver lead us first along the Mediterranean to the ruins of Caesarea, built by Herod the Great. Paul was imprisoned here, Cornelius and his household lived here and Pilate lived here during the time the crucifixion. Next we visit Mt. Carmel where Elijah slew the prophets of Baal. We drive to Tel Megiddo, 30 civilizations deep including a Canaanite altar, Ahab's water tunnel and Solomon's stables. Later in Nazareth we visit Mary's well.

DINNER AND OVERNIGHT GALILEE

NOV 4 **Boat Ride / Mt of Beatitudes / Tel Dan / Caesarea Philippi / Capernaum / Galilee**
 After breakfast, an inspiring boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. Visit the site of the Sermon on the Mount, then drive to Tel Dan, where Jeroboam challenged the temple in Jerusalem with a golden calf and Caesarea Philippi, site of pagan altars, where Peter confessed Christ. We return to Galilee and the traditional spot where Jesus laid out a breakfast for the Apostles and told Peter to *"Feed my sheep."* We visit Capernaum where the foundations of the temple where Jesus taught can still be seen and the outline of Peter's house remains.

DINNER AND OVERNIGHT GALILEE

NOV 5 **Gideon Springs / Beth Sh'ean / Jerusalem Bethlehem**

After breakfast, we leave for Jerusalem stopping at Gideon Springs where Gideon chose 300 men to fight the Midianites. Beth Sh'ean is next where the bodies of Saul and his sons were displayed on the walls after their Mount Gilboa defeat. Following the Jordan River Valley and the Judean Wilderness we check into our hotel in Jerusalem and travel to nearby Bethlehem. We visit the Shepherd's Fields, the Fields of Boaz and Ruth and visit the Church of the Nativity, site of Jesus' birth shop for olive wood souvenirs.

DINNER AND OVERNIGHT JERUSALEM

NOV 6 **Jerusalem / Old City**
 On the Mount of Olives, we visit the Chapel of the Ascension and the Garden of Gethsemane. We proceed through the Kidron Valley to the Temple Mount on Mt. Moriah and visit the archeological site at the southern wall and the Western Wall. We walk through the Kotel Tunnel to the Via Dolorosa and visit St. Stephen's Gate, the Pool of Bethesda, and the Chapel of the Flagellation. We follow the Via Dolorosa to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre before walking through the Bazaar to Mt Zion and the Room of the Last Supper.

DINNER AND OVERNIGHT JERUSALEM

NOV 7 **Jerusalem New City**
 We visit the Shrine of the Book to see the Dead Sea Scrolls and visit the model of ancient Jerusalem. We visit Yad Vashem, the holocaust memorial and in the early afternoon, the Garden Tomb where we have communion and worship.



DINNER AND OVERNIGHT JERUSALEM

NOV 8 **Dead Sea / Qumran / Ein Gedi / Masada**
 Today we visit the Dead Sea, beginning with the Essene ruins of Qumran where the Dead Sea scrolls were found. Further, we stop at Ein Gedi, where King David found shelter from the rage of King Saul. We continue to Masada and ascend by cable car to visit magnificent ruins. Between 70-73 AD Jewish Zealots made their last stand against Rome. Then we enjoy a short swim in the Dead Sea before returning to Jerusalem.

DINNER AND OVERNIGHT JERUSALEM

NOV 9 **Leisure Morning**
Valley of Ella / Jaffa; or depart for Jordan
 Our last morning in Jerusalem is yours to savor. In the afternoon we travel to the Valley of Ella where David slew Goliath; then, to Jaffa, home of Simon the Tanner and where Jonah set sail to encounter the great fish.

NOV 10 **Transatlantic / USA**

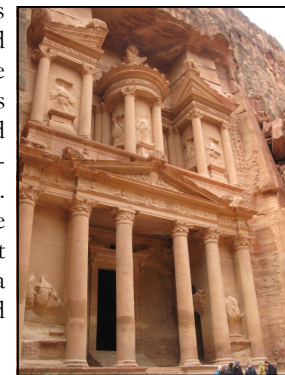
JORDAN ITINERARY

NOV 9 **Allenby Bridge**
Jerash / Madaba / Petra

Crossing the Allenby Bridge into Jordan near Jerusalem our Jordanian guide meets and transfers us to the ancient Decapolis city of Jerash. Another drive takes us to Madaba to see the oldest map known of the Holy Land. We continue southwards on the desert highway to Petra.

DINNER AND OVERNIGHT PETRA

NOV 10 **Petra**
 This morning we start our visit to Petra. This entire city, with its rose colored temples and amphitheatre is carved out of rocks surrounding the hidden valley. The city was lost to the rest of the world until approximately a hundred and fifty years ago. St. Paul studied here for three years and Herod the Great came from Petra. We have a day long visit to this world wonder.



DINNER AND OVERNIGHT PETRA

NOV 11 **Mt. Nebo / Baptismal Site / Allenby Bridge / El Ah Valley / Jaffa / Tel Aviv**

We leave very early this morning to historic Mt. Nebo where Moses saw the Promised Land and where we see a remarkable view of the Jordan Valley, The Dead Sea and the spires of Jerusalem in the distance. As we near the Allenby Bridge we stop at the probable site of Jesus' baptism. We can touch natural spring water like John used. We cross the Allenby Bridge back into Israel. In Israel we stop along the way to see El Ah Valley where David slew Goliath. Our final stop is Jaffa where Simon the Tanner lived and where Jonah sailed to his encounter with the big fish.
