- <u>Posters, Bulletin Boards, & TV's</u>- Signs are scattered all over the studio, letting you know of everything that is going on. Please walk around regularly to view bulletin boards, TV's and signs.
 <u>IF YOU DO NOT KNOW WHAT IS GOING ON PLEASE CHECK THE ABOVE!!</u>

Classes at Song and Dance...

- ◆ All classes are 55 minutes long. Allowing 5 minutes to switch in between classes.
- ✤ NO FOOD OR DRINKS are allowed in classroom. Water ONLY!
- Before class, please make sure the bathroom has been used and student gets a drink.
- You may observe classes in the observation room (TV Room) or by the observation windows. Theatre 3 and 4 do not have observation windows. Watching class inside the room is restricted.
- All students will be evaluated in beginner levels and moved up from there. Advanced placement will be solely at the discretion of the instructor and/or studio director.
- If you happen to miss a class you are allowed to make it up in the same level or level below. If the class missed is not available for a make-up, it will be allowed to be made up in ballet. Please stop by the front office to get a make-up slip.

- When registering for classes you are required to pay first and last month tuition. Last month tuition will be applied to the month of June. Unless you decide to cancel enrollment.
- There are <u>NO REFUNDS!</u> If you miss a class you will not be refunded. A 45-day written notice must be given to office to cancel enrollment. Your last month tuition will be applied to your last month attending.
- The monthly tuition is based on 11 months, 4 lessons per month. You will not be charged extra for months Imonth of June. You will be charged the entire tuition for these months.
- One Free trial class is provided to new students only. Additional trial classes are available at \$15 per class.
- Dress code must be followed in each style of dance. Dress code is available online or at front office. No crop tops without a shirt covering. Legs must always be covered by tights or pants.

Recital Process

\rightarrow RECITAL is Optional!

- \rightarrow Recital consent forms will be available from Nov. 1st Dec. 18th. These must be signed for each child whether they are participating in recital or not.
- → There is a \$55 fee per student participating in the recital. This fee includes the \$30 recital participation fee, recital souvenir t-shirt and snack pack for each day of recital. <u>NON-REFUNDABLE!</u>
- \rightarrow If participating in the recital there are 2 MANDATORY dress rehearsals and 2 MANDATORY days of recital.
- → Recital costumes are an average price of \$70 per costume. A \$40 deposit per costume is due upon recital consent. ONCE SIGNING CONSENT, YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE REMAINING BALANCE ON COSTUME.
- \rightarrow For recital you may be required to buy a certain shoe depending on color and style needed.
- → Tights must be purchased separately for each costume from Snazzy Dancewear. Orders will begin Feb 7th and end March 21st
- \rightarrow Recital tickets must be purchased to watch the show. At least one guardian MUST gbe present each day. Recital tickets go on sale May 2nd (Tickets are \$13 pre-order, \$15 at the door)
- \rightarrow DVD's, Medals, Trophies are optional and will be available for pre-order.

Christmas/Holiday Party

- Classes will be performing a Christmas/Holiday dance for each other DURING class time the last week before winter break.
- A party will be held immediately after the children share their dances. You will be asked the week before to bring one food/drink item so the children can enjoy a small party!!

Café

- Money can be added to account for weekly snacks and drinks.
- Please let café know if there are any restrictions to what your child may buy. (Ex: No Candy, Lactose Intolerant, No Soda, Juice or Water Only)
