

Ordinance to provide for stop sign on highways

STATE OF WISCONSIN
Town of Grant, Portage County
Ordinance # 2019-01

The Town Board of the Town of Grant, Portage County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s.349.07(8), Wis. Stats, to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the installation of stop signs on town highway in the town as follows:

- A. **Stop sign** shall be removed on Birch Drive in the town at the entrance of the road intersecting with Angle Drive
- B. **Yield sign** with a sign below that reads: “**Traffic from left does not stop**” shall be placed on Angle Drive in the town at the entrance of that road onto Birch Drive.
- C. **Yield Ahead sign** shall be placed at a required distance prior on Angle Drive in the town.

This ordinance is effective on April 30, 2019

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s 60.80. Wis. Stats.
