2016 Projects being scheduled:

- 1. Patio cleaning This will be done by request only. If you would like your patio cleaned, you must contact the Board at **BoardMembers@PinnacleGardens.org** so that arrangements can be made. The patio must be cleared of all belongings.
- 2. Roof replacement for Building #5 will be scheduled for this fall.
- 3. Arrangements are being made to insert a peep hole in the front doors. The Unit owner must contact the Board if they want this done and then a time can be arranged. Also, the owner will be responsible for the cost of the material which will be \$6.00 and state if it should be brass or nickel. Contact the Board at **BoardMembers@PinnacleGardens.org**
- 4. The floor boards of the decks will be replaced due to the mold issue. The Board is getting bids for the labor and owners will be notified when it is time for the work to be done. All belongings will have to be removed at that time.

COMMON SENSE CORNER

- CHARCOAL GRILLS when using a charcoal grill, cool coals should be discarded properly. Do not discard in the common area. This includes the drainage areas.
- LITTER Please keep our community looking clean and neat. This is your home! Please do not litter and if you see litter, please pick it up. This includes parking areas along with the common areas.
- 3. WATER KEYS Those of you that want to water plants or clean patio furniture, there is an in-ground water hydrant in the common area behind your building for your use. It does require a key which can be obtained by contacting the Board at BoardMembers@PinnacleGardens.org
- **TRASH CANS** Trash pickup is every Monday (if Holiday, the following day) by Waste Management. The garbage containers can be put out on Sunday evenings and **must be returned to the garage no later than Tuesday Noon.** Non-compliance is subject to fines. See the Rules and Regulations.
- **5. NO PARKING ON THE GRASSY AREAS** We are having a problem with people parking on the street and it is destroying the grass, which in turn costs money to repair. Please remember parking on the streets is a towable offense (at owner's expense).
- 6. DELINQUENCIES Unpaid maintenance fees and assessments has a chain reaction affect: a) people not being able to get financing; b) ability to sell property; and c) it affects the budget and your maintenance fees. As a result the Board contracted a Collection Agency to collect the outstanding balances at the owners expense. If you are in arrears, contact the Board to make arrangements for payment.
- **7. FLOWERS** Residents are welcome to plant flowers in the front area only if they are ANNUALS. Please do not plant perennials. If you do plant flowers, remember you are responsible for maintaining them.
- 8. CHANGES TO BACK PATIO AREA does require submitting the Grounds/Landscaping/ Architectural Design Replacement/Request Form which can be found under documents on the PG website. Making changes without doing so would be breaking the Rules & Regulations.

REACH ALERT — To improve our ability to communicate with you, we have made a special arrangement with Reach Alert to provide an easy to use notification service. We encourage every resident to register for this service. Registration is simple and takes about one minute to complete. You decide how you want to receive our alerts: text message, voice advisories, and/or e-mail. All you need to do is:

- 1. go to <u>www.reachalert.com</u> to register for the service.
- 2. Click on CREATE ACCOUNT
- 3. Follow the prompt and enter your contact information
- 4. Enter <u>Pinnacle Gardens</u> when asked which network you want to join. As you type, our name will appear in the drop-down list. Just click on our name.

Please help us keep our community looking nice by picking up after your pet.
