The March work detail got rained out. We notified everyone we could by email the day before. If you aren't getting emails from the club but would like to please email president@yorkiwla.org. When attending these work details always wear old clothes, boots and gloves. Bring saws, rakes and other similar implements to these first two work details. Trucks and trailers for moving brush and wood are a plus too. We will focusing on spring cleanup of the grounds in April and May.

LAKE TONIAN

The daily temperature fluctuations have been moving the fish around the pond recently. The warmer afternoons and evenings have the fish moving into the shallow waters. Seeing a "wolf pack" of male bass cruising the shoreline is becoming commonplace. If you look closely around these small collections of fish, you're likely to spot one or more much larger fish in the deeper water cruising along with them.

Fishing action has been sporadic, some days offer regular action, some days are simply made for casting practice. I really can't suggest any baits/techniques yet as nothing has been consistent for myself and my team.

Stern reminder: NOWHERE around the pond is it OK to build a fire.

2021 Pond regulations will continue as:

- All panfish are catch and immediate release back into the pond.
- All bass 12 inches and under are to be kept/removed from the pond. All bass over 12" are to be released back into the pond.
