Ribbon Point Value for awards: Blue -10 pts, Red -8 pts, and White -6 pts. Division 200 4-H Poultry Chain points are Blue -15 Pts., Red -10 Pts., and White -8 puts. Division 195 – Eggs, receive Blue -3 Pts., Red -2 Points, and White -1 point. No points for Grand and Reserve Champions.
