Jackman Community Daycare will be following the TDSB mandated vaccine policy, effective November 1, 2021.

We will be moving to emergent curriculum at Jackman, meaning that programming is done based solely on the interest of each child. Teachers plan and implement experiences based on children' cues, interests and ideas which often times leads into larger ongoing projects! This method of programming allows the classroom experiences to be child led and the environment to be a reflection of each individual child based on "<u>How Does Learning Happen</u>" Children are curious, capable leaders in their environment, our teachers look for opportunities to build on memorable experiences for children. # **Friendly Reminders**

Our staff are not permitted to enter any of the shared space classrooms during the school instructional day. We understand that children might forget articles of belongings such as boots, indoor shoes, water bottles etc. unfortunately we are unable to get inside the classroom to retrieve any items for your child. Our teachers will continue to do their best and remind children to gather all personal belongings for the school day, especially as the weather gets cooler in which children would be coming to school with additional weather appropriate belongings. We kindly ask you to remind your child they must take everything they need with them for school as they will be unable to get back into their daycare classroom until the end of the school day.

If your child will be absent from care, please call the <u>room extension</u> directly to speak to one of the teachers, or leave a message. We ask that absences be reported the day before or before noon the day of. This will help us ensure the safe pick up and arrival of all children in our care. If siblings will be absent, you can leave one message and ask that the absence information of the sibling be relayed to the appropriate daycare room.

You are able to pick up your child(ren) from the schoolyard after school however you <u>MUST</u> communicate directly with your child's teacher before leaving. <u>Waving your child down in the schoolyard is not permitted</u> as this does not give our teachers the opportunity to update their attendance records, which must be accurate at all times for the safety of all children. It is even more challenging with us all wearing masks, we don't always recognize each person, therefore cannot stress enough the importance of communicating directly with our teachers before leaving.

#### Masks

Children in Kindergarten to Grade 6 will follow the same outdoor rules and regulations as the TDSB, no masks are required outdoors however masks must be worn indoors at all times. There is no change to preschool or nursery school protocols, masks are to be worn indoors and outdoors at all times.
