# DUVER RETURNS TO WINNER'S CIRCLE FOR 4th TIME MINER RALLIES TO WIN CROWN # 2

#### MINER EMERGES FROM PACKED LEADERBOARD TO CLAIM VICTORY

Jayson Miner emerged from a jam-packed leaderboard to claim the 2nd title of his tour career at this month's event in Muscatine.

This month's boy's finals featured one of the most jam-packed leaderboards in the history of the GISBT. After 15 games, the top 5 were separated by a mere 54 pins, and just 119 pins spanned the entire 8-player finals field. Jayson Miner held a slim 3-pin lead going into the position round, and he quickly eliminated any drama by firing an 8-bagger to start his final match. The resulting 265-217 win over Zack Denton gave him an 81-pin victory, and his 2nd tour title; he earned his first championship at August's Tournament of Champions.

This victory was truly earned the hard way – but guts and resiliency. After 4 games of qualifying, the Silvis, Illinois resident found himself at -99 – and significantly behind the cut line. Over his closing 4 games of qualifying, he turned the tables, averaging 228, and qualifying for the finals (his 13th) in 5th place. Once the finals began, Miner seized the newfound opportunity, dipping below 200 just once and averaging 233.37 for his 8 games, and posting a 5-3 match play ledger.

For his victory, the Silvis, Illinois resident earned a \$400 scholarship. Miner averaged 217.56 for his 16 games. Congratulations, Jayson!

#### **DENTON FINISHES RUNNER-UP**

Zack Denton turned in the highest finish of his tour career at this month's stop – a runner-up showing that garnered him a \$300 scholarship. Denton was appearing in the 8th match play finals of his career.

The right-hander from Waverly, Iowa led the field in qualifying by averaging 210.12 for 8 games on the challenging Autobahn lane pattern, and that allowed him to tote a slim 11-pin lead into the finals. He now owns 3 consecutive match play finals appearances, and as a result, he's moved into the lead in the 2021-2022 Bowler of the Year race.

#### **ERICKSON TAKES 3rd**

Isaac Erickson continued his fine bowling this month with a 3rd place finish. The Lititz, Pennsylvania native has enjoyed a successful season, qualifying for the match play finals in all 3 events in which he's competed. This was his 5th match play finals, and he earned a \$200 scholarship for his performance.

#### **JACOBSON 4th IN MATCH PLAY DEBUT**

Coleton Jacobson has been a new face on the GISBT scene in 2021-2022. This month, he enjoyed his best finish on tour, with a 4th place showing that netted him a \$175 payday. The West Jordan, Utah native was on fire over the closing stretch, averaging 247 for his final 5 matches, while winning all 5. As a result, he charged from 8th place into contention.

#### **PAST CHAMP LUGO GRABS 5th**

Luis Lugo, one of 3 past champions in the boy's finals field, took home 5th place. The smooth-stroking right-hander from Mexico earned a \$150 scholarship for his day's work. This was his 3rd career match play finals appearance.

#### **NOVICK 6th IN TOUR DEBUT**

Joey Novick made his tour debut a successful one. The right-hander from Lapeer, Michigan finishes in 6th place, earning a \$135 scholarship for his day's work.

#### **MASTROIANNI PLACES 7th**

Anthony Mastroianni was this month's 7th place finisher. The stocky Brooklyn, New York native was appearing in just his 4th GISBT, and this was his first trip into the match play finals; he earned a \$120 scholarship for his efforts.

#### **PAST CHAMP JONES FINISHES 8th**

William Jones completed this month's boy's finals field. In the 6th match play finals of his career, the right-hander from Anoka, Minnesota earned a \$110 scholarship for his 8th place performance.

#### DUVER-BORROZ RETURNS TO WINNER'S CIRCLE AFTER 3 YEAR WAIT

#### **DUVER-BORROZ WINS TITLE # 4 IN THRILLING FINISH**

Hanna Duver began her tour career way back in March 2010 a a 10 year-old, and has enjoyed one of the longest, but also most successful careers in GISBT history. This month, the talented right-hander charged from behind to claim her 4th tour championship, but her first in 3 years.

As the champion explained following her victory, Hanna Duver stated "I love this place." Indeed! Duver captured her first title at the Muscatine center on November 6, 2016 – 5 years ago. She also earned the most recent of her 4 titles at the same center – on November 4, 2018. And now – 3 years later – she reeled in championship #4. And thus; 3 of her 4 titles have come at Rose Bowl. This time around, the champ reeled in a \$300 scholarship, and that pushed her tour earnings to \$6,055, which currently ranks 7th on the girl's all time earnings list.

3 years between victories is one of the longest stretches in tour annals, but it's not the longest. That record belongs to Jonica Matson, who captured 2 tour titles, with those coming 57 months apart – on November 14, 1999 and not again until August 8, 2004.

The Indianola, Iowa resident continues to add to her amazing GISBT resume. This month, Duver was appearing in the 35th match play finals of her tour career; only 4 players in the girls division have qualified for more match play finals (Emily Papke with 50, Katie Maher with 44, Brittany Smith with 42 and Kayla Crawford with 39). Her career pinfall total now stands at 169,196 (trailing only Emily Papke's 180,051, and her 858 games bowled in GISBT competition, and her 858 games bowled also ranks 2nd all-time behind Emily Papke's 897 games bowled. For her 14 games, the champ averaged 197.64. Congratulations, Hanna!

#### **2-TIME CHAMP MADISON EARNS RUNNER-UP**

Brynna Madison continues her great bowling in 2021-2022. This month, Madison parlayed consistency into a runner-up finish, earning \$200. Madison found herself trailing by 270 pins with 4 matches remaining, but she won her closing 4 contests, and just 10 pins eventually stood between herself and 3rd tour title.

As a result of her runner-up finish, the right-hander from Lincoln, Nebraska maintained her Bowler of the Year lead after 4 events.

#### **HESS TAKES 3rd**

Megan Hess opened her qualifying round with 244, and immediately established herself as the bowler to beat. Hess, already a 5-time champion on tour, was gunning for back-to-back titles for the 2nd time in her GISBT career.

The 5-time champion led the field by 57 pins after qualifying, and stretched that lead to 166 pins with 4 games remaining. That's when the struggles began, and the right-hander from Granger, lowa watched her advantage shrink to just 44 pins heading into the position round. There, she was bumped off by Hanna Duver 201-172, which dropped Hess into 3rd place. In the 14th finals of her career, she took home a \$175 scholarship.

#### **MOORE FINISHES 4th**

Rachel Moore was this month's 4th place finisher. The slender right-hander from Keokuk, Iowa earned a \$150 scholarship by virtue of her performance. This marked the 11th match play finals of her career. Moore captured her first tour title at this season's September event in Waterloo, and she was one of 4 past champions among this month's girl's match play finalists.

#### **MAGSAM PLACES 5th**

Qualifying for the 3rd match play finals of her tour career, Keira Magsam finished in 5th place. The 15 yearold actually withdrew from her final match with 4 frames to go due to injury, but still had enough pins to hang on to 5th place. In the process, the Gretna, Nebraska resident earned a \$125 scholarship.

#### **EVANS EARNS 6th**

Gabi Evans rounded out this month's girl's finals field. The right-hander from West Liberty, Iowa took home a \$110 scholarship for her efforts; this was her 9th career match play finals appearance.
