Overview: I met Mitsuaki Hanzawa (Aki), owner and tour guide of Atlas International, Inc., at the Mescal trailhead at 6:00am. I went on the hike with two other individuals, who Aki drove to the trailhead in the company vehicle. Aki began the excursion with introductions, then pointed out the information on the kiosk at the trailhead. He used the trailhead map to explain the route we would be hiking (Chuckwagon Trail to Devil's Bridge Trail) to reach our final destination, Devil's Bridge. Once on the trail, Aki stopped periodically to talk about the plants, animals, and geology of the area and to allow time for taking pictures. Additionally, Aki picked up trash along the hike and made a point to educate his client's about the importance of staying on the trail. When we returned to the trailhead I asked to see the special use permit, which Aki was able to provide.

<u>Interpretation:</u> Aki's knowledge of the local flora, fauna, and geology was good. Aki would stop periodically during the hike to point out the different plants of the area including the different cacti, trees, and flowers. During the hike, Aki also spoke about the geology of the area as well as the landmarks that were visible during the hike such as the canyons and mountains. Aki is a great interpreter which can be seen by how he educates his clients, leads by example, and is inclusive of all participants.

<u>Safety:</u> Aki was well-prepared for our hiking excursion and practiced safety throughout the excursion. He carried a first aid-kit during the hike and before we began the excursion Aki made sure everyone was warm enough, since it was an unusually cold morning.

<u>Summary:</u> Aki, representing Atlas America International, Inc., conducted operations in a satisfactory manner and in compliance with the special use permit issued by the Red Rock Ranger District of the Coconino National Forest.
