**AFTERNOON PICK UP:** Please keep your car rider sign clearly visible until you exit the parking lot with your child. Parents may stand next to their vehicle once they have stopped in the front pick-up section with the engine turned off. Please do not park outside the lot and walk to the doors for pickup during the afternoon dismissal, as it is difficult to dismiss the children this way.

**EARLY PICKUP:** If you need to pick up your child from school early, please notify the school office with the time. The cutoff time for early pickups is **2:30pm**, so that staff may prepare for regular dismissal.

**KINDNESS T-SHIRTS:** Students may wear their blue tie-dye Kindness t-shirts on the first Monday of every month, with school uniform shorts, pants, skirts, or jumpers.
