TUITION

- Classes are offered on a yearly basis broken into monthly payments, regardless of how many weeks are in a month.
- Tuition is based on the year – September through June – not on the individual class.
- **Tuition is due by the 10th of each month for that month's classes.**

- A Late Fee will be charged to your account if payment is not received by the 10th of each month.
- Tuition will be charged unless and until you notify the office that a student has dropped a class.

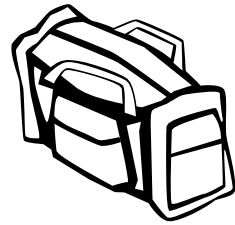

Each dancer should come prepared for class. A Dancer's Bag is a great way to make sure you are ready for any situation. What should be packed in your bag...?

- ✓ **Shoes**
- ✓ **Extra Tights and/or leotard**
- ✓ **Hair brush, gummies and extra clips**
- ✓ **Deodorant**
- ✓ **Snacks**
- ✓ **Water Bottle**
- ✓ **Band-aids and tape**

Place everything in a bag that is devoted to dance class. It is always packed and ready to go!!



SNOW POLICY

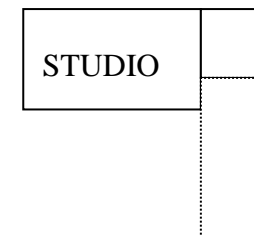
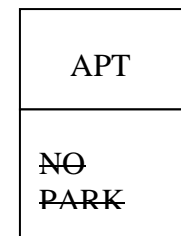

ATTENTION ALL STUDENTS & PARENTS

- ❖ Here at the studio we do our best to stick to the schedule allotted for class. To do so requires that students **arrive on time and are ready to go**. It is important for the students to begin class together. We give a class designed to properly warm up the student for the exercises to follow. Without proper warm up the risk of injury increases. As parents and leaders we need to do our best to show the most responsible attention to these details. While we cannot prevent you from leaving class early, we do discourage it. When this occurs frequently it hampers the students' development.
- ❖ I do understand that your children are involved in many activities, however, if your child is enrolled in a class they have a certain obligation to that class. I have to wonder if we are doing best by them when we over-involve them.
- ❖ ***In the event that you are late*** please remind your child to enter the classroom in a respectful manner with as little distraction as possible when the next break in activity occurs. No student entering the classroom late should stand in the front of the room. They should enter quietly and take a place at the back.
- ❖ Additionally, **there is a dress code** outlined elsewhere. When the dress code is ignored the child will be asked to sit and watch the class.

ATTENDANCE POLICY *UPPER LEVELS 5-8 ONLY*

It is the policy of the studio regarding the upper level classes that a minimum of 80 % of classes is attended and 'made-up' prior to the Holiday Break for the student to participate in the year-end recital.

All upper level students are aware of this policy, as it has been in place for many years. It is the student's responsibility to check on their attendance, which will be posted on a monthly basis, and make sure it is meeting the standards of 80%.

Furthermore, good attendance should be maintained after the Holiday Break. Understand that consistent absence will result in you being pulled from missed sections of the choreography. The last time to have classes made up for inclusion in choreography is the end of April. If you have any questions or concerns regarding this policy please speak to me earlier than later.

REQUIRED DANCEWEAR POLICY

The student's appearance in class is very important to the overall sense of order and discipline in dance education. When the student prepares for class the teacher is aware that the student is thinking of what is about to happen and is ready to give his or her all to the experience. It is inappropriate to wear a basketball uniform for swimming lessons.... Etc.... therefore I will NOT allow students to wear soccer clothes, cheerleading uniforms, boxer shorts and t-shirts to class. It exhibits a lack of interest in doing things the right way. I highly recommend for economy sake that the older students purchase good dancewear. It will hold up in the washer for several years. Younger students may get away with less durable garments.

DO NOT ALLOW YOUR CHILDREN TO WEAR OVERSIZED T-SHIRTS, BAGGY SHORTS AND PANTS IN CLASS. THEY WILL BE ASKED TO REMOVE THEM!!!

A NOTE TO ACRO STUDENTS: YOU WILL BE UPSIDE DOWN AND TIED IN KNOTS.... BE PREPARED...!

STUDENTS WHO ARE NOT PREPARED FOR CLASS WILL BE ASKED TO OBSERVE RATHER THAN PARTICIPATE.

## CREATIVE MOVEMENT & INTRO TO DANCE CLASSES

Solid color leotards. May have attached skirt and decoration on leotard. Pink or nude tights... no runs. Hair in a ponytail or bun, or if short held off of face with headband. Pink ballet slippers and black or tan tap shoes.

## COMBO CLASSES 1-4

Solid color leotards. May have *removable* skirts for ballet portion of class. NO SHORTS AND OVERSHIRTS. Tights must be convertibles in pink, nude or black...no runs. Hair in a ponytail or bun, or if short held off of face with headband. Pink ballet slippers and tan tap shoes.

## BALLET LEVEL 5-8 & POINTE

Solid color leotards. May have a removable skirt or practice tutu. NO SHORTS AND OVERSHIRTS. Tights must be pink or nude... no runs. Hair must be in a bun. Pink ballet slippers and pointe shoes.

## JAZZ, MODERN, TAP & MUSICAL THEATER LEVEL 5-8

Solid color leotards and tights or crop tops and leggings. Bootie shorts may be worn over tights. NO LOOSE TOPS OR CAMISOLES. Hair must be in a ponytail or bun. No shoes are required although you may wear foot undies.

## ACRO CLASSES ALL LEVELS

Solid color leotards and footless tights. Bootie short unitards also accepted when worn with footless tights. NO SHORTS OR T-SHIRTS. Hair in ponytail, pigtailed or braids.

## HIP HOP LEVEL 1-7

Students may wear a loose top over a crop top or leotard. All leg coverings must go below the knee. A dedicated pair of tennis shoes is required. NO outside shoes may be worn in the studio. Hair may be down but should be secured out of the face with a headband or a hat.

# What to do when I miss a class????

Please use the following guide to make-up classes missed for any reason. It is not necessary to call ahead of time. Simply inform the instructor of the child's regular class so they may be marked in attendance. The classes are grouped in the most compatible way. It is best to move up or down one level only.
