NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD ON
DESIRED FUTURE CONDITIONS OF DISTRICT AQUIFERS

Notice is hereby given that a 90-day public comment period opened on May 13, 2016 to take comments on proposed Desired Future Conditions for the District's aquifers which were adopted by designated representatives of Groundwater Management Area 7 at a joint planning meeting held on April 21, 2016, pursuant to Section 36.108 (d-2) of the Texas Water Code.

The District's aquifers for which proposed Desired Future Conditions were adopted are:

Dockum Aquifer
Edwards-Trinity (Plateau) Aquifer

The District will schedule a Public Hearing to take oral and written comments on the proposed Desired Future Conditions prior to the **expiration of the public comment period on August 11, 2016.**

The district will accept written comments on the proposed Desired Future Conditions at any time until 5:00 p. m. on Thursday, August 11, 2016. Comments should be mailed to:
