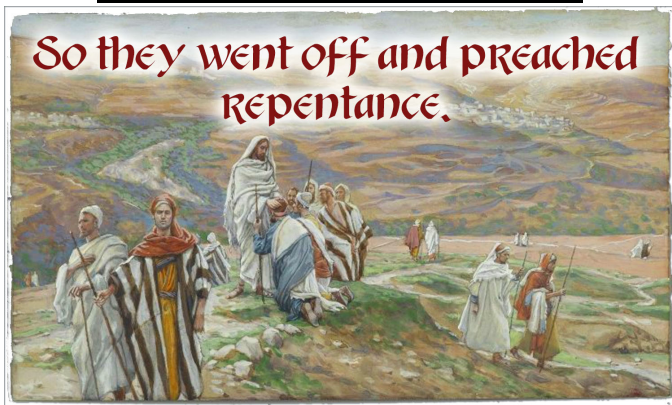

Jesus summoned the Twelve and began to send them out.
(Mark 6: 7)

How do you think the apostles reacted when Jesus told them he was sending them out to preach, heal the sick, and drive out demons? Maybe they had a moment of panic, or at least some trepidation. They probably wondered if they could do what he was asking!

No matter how they felt, the Twelve were able to go out and minister to the surrounding towns because they believed in Jesus. If he was calling them to this work, then they trusted that he would help them to accomplish it.

That's the kind of faith we all need when God calls us to do something, we feel unqualified or unworthy to carry out:

- Faith that Jesus is truly calling us and "sending us out" in some way. That kind of faith requires you to trust that he has some kind of mission just for you and that through prayer or in Adoration, you will hear what he has in mind.
- Faith that the Lord will equip us to do this work. You may see only what you lack, but the Lord sees all your gifts, some of which you might not even be aware of. He has confidence in your abilities, and he might even send you new gifts—as well as other believers—to help you.
- Faith that our efforts will bear fruit. You might not see such fruit immediately, and perhaps you will never see it in your lifetime. But you can trust that the Lord had a purpose for you in mind and that if you are faithful to him, he will be faithful to you.

Where is God sending you today? It might not require you to "go" very far—it could very well be to your parish, neighborhood, or workplace. And unlike the apostles, you can bring more than a walking stick with you! What do you need is a heaping amount of faith—and the Lord will give it to you if you ask for it!

"Lord, fill me with faith, and then send me out to join you in your saving work!"

WHY PRAY THE ROSARY?

"Love the Madonna and pray the Rosary, for her Rosary is the weapon against the evils of the world today."

The Rosary has been the weapon of choice for saints, kings, queens, peasants, warrior poets, maidens, missionaries, and misfits for centuries. But why *do* we call this sacramental a "weapon"?

We call it that because it's one of our best defenses against our mortal enemy, the devil. We are truly engaged in a spiritual war at all times, and Satan, as St. Peter says, "prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour" (1 Peter 5:8). The devil never sleeps and never tires. He is always plotting our downfall, and we've got to be on the offensive against him if we are to spiritually survive and make it to heaven.

If we're going up against the devil, we'd best be fighting under the banner of Our Lady. The devil fears her like he fears no one else. She is like "an army set in battle array" (Song of Songs 6:10) against the forces of evil. She has given her warriors a special weapon for the fight, and they carry her Rosary like a sword at their side.

In fact, those in religious life carry their rosaries on the left side, hanging from their belt, because this is the traditional place for a sword!

If you are a parent, grandparent, or godparent, you know the urgency behind raising your children in a faithful manner to prepare them for both their earthly and eternal life. *The Rosary is a powerful weapon to pass on to the next generation.*
