



### Tuition Reduction Rates

If students choose to, they can pay for several classes at once earning them a graduated discount. Students do not need to decide at the time of payment which courses they want; they can even choose courses that are newly added at the same price. Paying for the classes all at once simply earns a discount and locks in tuition so that the cost of the pre-paid classes can never be raised.

- 5% for 4 classes (\$25 savings)
- 10% for 8 classes (\$100 savings)
- 15% for 12 classes (\$225 savings)
- 20% for 16 classes (\$400 savings)

#### Examples:

Teacher's Diploma	<b>8 classes at \$125 =</b>	<b>\$1,000</b>
	<b>10% discount</b>	<b>-\$100</b>
<b>Total Cost</b>		<b>\$900</b>

Associates Degree	<b>16 classes at \$125 =</b>	<b>\$2,000</b>
	<b>20% discount</b>	<b>-\$400</b>
<b>Total Cost</b>		<b>\$1,600 + Trinity graduation fees</b>
