

SSSAA Track and Field Meet of SSSAA

The tenth Annual track and field of SSSAA was held on Monday, May 6, 1968 and Tuesday May 7, 1968.

The Scits Key Club Trophy for Senior Boys was won by Northern with 80 points.

The Individual Senior winners was Brent McFarlane of Scits with 14 Points.

The W. Rogers Intermediate Boys trophy was won by Central with 80½ points.

The Individual Intermediate Championship was a tie between Art Douswell and Glenn Close of Central with 12 points each.

The J. E. Johnston Junior Boys trophy was won by Scits with 58 points.

The Individual Junior winner was Brian McDonald of St. Pats with 18 points

Eleven records were set in this meet.

Sarnia Athletes competed in WOBSA on Saturday May 20, 1968 at London and Northern won the Senior Boys title and Central won the Intermediate Boys title.

Paul Wormith of Northern tied the WOBSA record for the 100yd. Dash (10.0) sec.

Vince Evers of Central set WOBSA records in the 440 (50.9) and the 880 (2:00.0). Glenn Clark set a WOBSA record in the hurdled (15.3) and Centrals 880 yd. relay team set a record of 1:339

Several Sarnia Athletes competed in OPSAA on Saturday May 25, 1968 in Toronto at the CNE stadium.

Résh Douswell of Sarnia Central set an Intermediate Junior Record of 180'3". Vince Evers of Central was first in the Intermediate 880 yd. run with a time of 1:57.3 and Gerry Getty of Scits had a winning toss of 157'11" in the Junior Javelin.

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR 1969

1. That the division names be changed to Senior Junior, Midjet
2. That the Javelin and discus events continue to be held 1 week prior to the meet.
3. That a new 10-8-6-4-2-1-scoring system be used, because we now have 6 teams.
4. That the 1969 meet be held on Monday, May 5, 1969 and Tues. May 6, 1969
5. That only Central being the Javelin and Discus necessary to run the events. Practice throws will be allowed. Many thanks to the Athletes coaches and officials who made this years' meet such a great success.
6. That the resignation of the convenor of the past 10 years be accepted, at this time.
